

1 AN ACT concerning safety.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of**
2 **Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Fire Investigation Act is amended by
5 changing Section 13.1 as follows:

6 (425 ILCS 25/13.1) (from Ch. 127 1/2, par. 17.1)

7 Sec. 13.1. Fire Prevention Fund.

8 (a) There shall be a special fund in the State
8 Treasury

9 known as the Fire Prevention Fund.

10 (b) The following moneys shall be deposited into the
10 Fund:

11 (1) Moneys received by the Department of
11 Insurance

12 under Section 12 of this Act.

13 (2) All fees and reimbursements received by the
13 Office

14 of the State Fire Marshal.

15 (3) All receipts from boiler and pressure vessel
15 certification, as provided in Section 13 of the Boiler
16 and

17 Pressure Vessel Safety Act.

18 (4) Such other moneys as may be provided by law.

19 (c) The moneys in the Fire Prevention Fund shall be
19 used,

20 subject to appropriation, for the following purposes:

21 (1) Of the moneys deposited into the fund under
21 Section

22 12 of this Act, 12.5% shall be available for the
22 maintenance of the Illinois Fire Service Institute and
23 the

1 expenses, facilities, and structures incident thereto,
2 and

2 for making transfers into the General Obligation Bond
3 Retirement and Interest Fund for debt service
requirements

4 on bonds issued by the State of Illinois after January
1,

5 1986 for the purpose of constructing a training
facility

6 for use by the Institute.

7 (1.5) Of the moneys deposited into the fund
under

8 Section 12 of this Act, an additional 2.5% shall be
9 available for the use of the Illinois Fire Service
10 Institute for the purpose of implementing the
Cornerstone

11 program.

12 (2) Of the moneys deposited into the Fund under
Section

13 12 of this Act, 10% shall be available for the
maintenance

14 of the Chicago Fire Department Training Program and
the

15 expenses, facilities and structures incident thereto,
in

16 addition to any moneys payable from the Fund to the
City of

17 Chicago pursuant to the Illinois Fire Protection
Training

18 Act.

19 (3) For making payments to local governmental
agencies

20 and individuals pursuant to Section 10 of the Illinois
Fire

21 Protection Training Act.

22 (4) For the maintenance and operation of the
Office of

23 the State Fire Marshal, and the expenses incident
thereto.

24 (5) For any other purpose authorized by law.

25 (c-5) As soon as possible after the effective date
of this

26 amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly, the
Comptroller

1 shall order the transfer and the Treasurer shall
2 transfer
2 \$2,000,000 from the Fire Prevention Fund to the Fire

3 and Small Equipment Fund, \$9,000,000 from the Fire

4 Fund to the Fire Truck Revolving Loan Fund, and
4 \$4,000,000 from
5 the Fire Prevention Fund to the Ambulance Revolving Loan
5 Fund.

6 Beginning on July 1, 2008, each month, or as soon as
6 practical

7 thereafter, an amount equal to \$2 from each fine
7 received shall

8 be transferred from the Fire Prevention Fund to the Fire
9 Service and Small Equipment Fund, an amount equal to
9 \$1.50 from

10 each fine received shall be transferred from the Fire
11 Prevention Fund to the Fire Truck Revolving Loan Fund,
11 and an

12 amount equal to \$4 from each fine received shall be
12 transferred

13 from the Fire Prevention Fund to the Ambulance Revolving
13 Loan

14 Fund. These moneys shall be transferred from the moneys
15 deposited into the Fire Prevention Fund pursuant to
15 Public Act

16 95-154, together with not more than 25% of any unspent
17 appropriations from the prior fiscal year. These moneys
17 may be

18 allocated to the Fire Truck Revolving Loan Fund,
18 Ambulance

19 Revolving Loan Fund, and Fire Service and Small
19 Equipment Fund

20 at the discretion of the Office of the State Fire
20 Marshal for

21 the purpose of implementation of this Act.
22 (d) Any portion of the Fire Prevention Fund
23 remaining
24 unexpended at the end of any fiscal year which is not
25 needed
26 for the maintenance and expenses of the Office of the
State
Fire Marshal or the maintenance and expenses of the
Illinois
Fire Service Institute, shall remain in the Fire
Prevention

1 Fund for the exclusive and restricted uses provided in
2 subsections (c) and (c-5) of this Section.

3 (d-5) The Fire Prevention Fund is not subject to
4 administrative charges or charge-backs, including but
5 not
5 limited to those authorized under Section 8h of the
5 State
6 Finance Act.

7 (e) The Office of the State Fire Marshal shall keep
on file
8 an itemized statement of all expenses incurred which are
9 payable from the Fund, other than expenses incurred by
the
10 Illinois Fire Service Institute, and shall approve all
vouchers
11 issued therefor before they are submitted to the State
12 Comptroller for payment. Such vouchers shall be allowed
and
13 paid in the same manner as other claims against the
State.
