## A JOINT RESOLUTION

TO APPROPRIATE MONIES FROM THE CAPITAL RESERVE FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 20112012, AND TO ALLOW UNEXPENDED FUNDS APPROPRIATED TO BE CARRIED FORWARD TO SUCCEEDING FISCAL YEARS AND EXPENDED FOR THE SAME PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina:

SECTION 1. In accordance with the provisions of Section 36(B)(2) and (3), Article III, Constitution of South Carolina, 1895, and Section 1111320(C) and (D) of the 1976 Code, there is appropriated from the monies available in the Capital Reserve Fund for Fiscal Year 20112012 the following amounts:

 31 appropriated pursuant to this joint resolution may be carried  
 32 forward to succeeding fiscal years and expended for the same  
 33 purposes.

35 SECTION 3. This joint resolution takes effect thirty days after the  
 36 completion of the 20112012 fiscal year in accordance with the  
 37 provisions of Section 36(B)(3)(a), Article III, Constitution of South  
 38 Carolina, 1895, and Section 1111320(D)(1) of the 1976 Code.
