Citizens' and Students' Self-Defense Act.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to firearms; removing and repealing
2 restriction on the carrying of firearms in certain areas as
3 specified; providing for the carrying of firearms by permit
4 holders as specified; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 6-8-105 is created to read:

9

10 **6-8-105. Special exceptions for state issued**
11 **concealed carry permits.**

12

13 (a) Persons holding a valid concealed carry permit
14 issued by the state of Wyoming under W.S. 6-8-104(a)(ii)
15 may carry a firearm in the following places:

1

2 (i) Any school, college or professional athletic
3 event conducted on public property;

4

5 (ii) Any public college or university facility.

6

7 (b) Permanent employees of a school district who hold
8 a valid concealed carry permit issued by the state of
9 Wyoming under W.S. 6-8-104(a)(ii) may carry a concealed
10 firearm on or into any facility of the school district,
11 provided the employee first notifies the following persons
12 that the employee intends to carry a concealed firearm on
13 or into a school district facility:

14

15 (i) The superintendent of the school district;
16 and

17

18 (ii) The principal of the school at which the
19 employee is employed, or other person with responsibility
20 for the school district facility at which the employee is
21 employed.

22

23 (c) The superintendent of the school district shall
24 inform all law enforcement agencies with jurisdiction over

1 the area in which the school district facility is located
2 of all permanent employees providing notice pursuant to
3 subsection (b) of this section. Information provided under
4 this subsection shall only be used by local law enforcement
5 in preparing for a response to any potential incident at a
6 school district facility.

7
8 (d) In addition to those persons specified in
9 subsection (b) of this section, persons who hold a valid
10 concealed carry permit issued by the state of Wyoming under
11 W.S. 6-8-104(a)(ii) may carry a concealed firearm on or
12 into a school or facility of the school district, provided:

13
14 (i) The person is the parent or legal guardian
15 of a student currently enrolled in the school or school
16 district facility;

17
18 (ii) Upon entering the school or school district
19 facility, the person notifies the principal of the school
20 or other person with responsibility for the school district
21 facility that the person intends to carry a concealed
22 firearm on or into the school or school district facility.

23

1 (e) Nothing in this section shall authorize a current
2 student of a school district to carry a concealed firearm
3 on or into any facility of a school district.

4
5 (f) If the entrance to any place described in
6 subsections (a), (b) and (d) of this section is secured by
7 metal detectors, the permit holder shall show his permit to
8 the security officer stationed there.

9
10 (g) Any person carrying a firearm pursuant to this
11 section shall at all times maintain the firearm on his
12 person or within a container kept within his immediate
13 control.

14
15 **Section 2.** W.S. 6-8-104(t)(intro) is amended to read:

16
17 **6-8-104. Wearing or carrying concealed weapons;**
18 **penalties; exceptions; permits.**

19
20 (t) Except as provided in W.S. 6-8-105, no person
21 authorized to carry a concealed weapon pursuant to
22 paragraphs (a)(ii) through (iv) of this section shall carry
23 a concealed firearm into:

24

1 **Section 3.** W.S. 6-8-104(t)(v) is repealed.

2

3 **Section 4.** This act is effective immediately upon
4 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
5 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
6 Constitution.
