HOUSE BILL NO. 1009 (As Sent to Governor)

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 43-1-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES TO CONTRACT
- 3 WITH VENDORS OR CONTRACTORS TO IMPROVE THE PERFORMANCE AND
- 4 EFFICIENCY OF ITS SERVICES; TO REQUIRE ADVANCE LEGISLATIVE
- 5 APPROVAL BEFORE A COUNTY OFFICE OF THE DEPARTMENT MAY BE CLOSED;
- 6 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 **SECTION 1.** Section 43-1-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 9 amended as follows:
- 10 43-1-3. Notwithstanding the authority granted under
- 11 subsection (4)(d) of Section 43-1-2, the Department of Human
- 12 Services or the Executive Director of Human Services shall not be
- 13 authorized to delegate, privatize or otherwise enter into a
- 14 contract with a private entity for the operation of any office,
- 15 bureau or division of the department, as defined in Section
- 16 7-17-11, without specific authority to do so by general act of the
- 17 Legislature. However, nothing in this section shall be construed
- 18 to invalidate (i) any contract of the department that is in place
- 19 and operational before January 1, 1994; or (ii) the continued
- 20 renewal of any such contract with the same entity upon the

21	expiration of the contract; or (iii) the execution of a contract
22	with another legal entity as a replacement of any such contract
23	that is expiring, provided that the replacement contract is
24	substantially the same as the expiring contract. Nothing in this
25	section shall prohibit the Department of Human Services or the
26	Executive Director of Human Services from entering into any
27	contract with vendors or contractors intended to improve
28	performance, reduce costs or increase efficiency, so long as the
29	contract remains under the supervision or control of an office,
30	bureau or division of the department, and provided that no county
31	office of the department may be closed unless the Legislature
32	specifically authorizes its closure in advance of the closure.
33	This section shall stand repealed on July 1, 2015.
34	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after July 1, 2013.

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
