## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act incorporating provisions related to pregnancy and fetal
- 2 development into the human growth and development and health
- 3 curricula provided by school districts, accredited nonpublic
- 4 schools, charter schools, and innovation zone schools to
- 5 students enrolled in grades four through twelve.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

## S.F. 175

- 1 Section 1. Section 256.11, subsections 3 and 4, Code 2025,
- 2 are amended to read as follows:
- 3 3. a. The following areas shall be taught in grades
- 4 one through six: English-language arts, social studies,
- 5 mathematics, science, health, physical education, traffic
- 6 safety, music, visual art, and, subject to section 279.80,
- 7 age-appropriate and research-based human growth and
- 8 development.
- 9 b. Computer science instruction incorporating the standards
- 10 established under section 256.7, subsection 26, paragraph "a",
- 11 subparagraph (4), shall be offered in at least one grade level
- 12 commencing with the school year beginning July 1, 2023.
- 13 c. In grades four through six, the age-appropriate and
- 14 research-based human growth and development instruction shall
- 15 incorporate the standards established under section 279.50,
- 16 subsection 2, paragraph "b".
- 17 d. The health curriculum shall include the characteristics
- 18 of communicable diseases.
- 19 e. The state board as part of accreditation standards shall
- 20 adopt curriculum definitions for implementing the elementary
- 21 program.
- 22 4. The following shall be taught in grades seven and
- 23 eight: English-language arts; social studies, including
- 24 instruction related to civics; mathematics; science; health;
- 25 age-appropriate and research-based human growth and development
- 26 that incorporates the standards established under section
- 27 279.50, subsection 3, paragraph "b"; career exploration
- 28 and development; physical education; music; and visual art.
- 29 Computer science instruction incorporating the standards
- 30 established under section 256.7, subsection 26, paragraph "a",
- 31 subparagraph (4), shall be offered in at least one grade level
- 32 commencing with the school year beginning July 1, 2023. Career
- 33 exploration and development shall be designed so that students
- 34 are appropriately prepared to create an individual career
- 35 and academic plan pursuant to section 279.61, incorporate

- 1 foundational career and technical education concepts aligned
- 2 with the six career and technical education service areas as
- 3 defined in subsection 5, paragraph "h", incorporate relevant
- 4 twenty-first century skills to facilitate career readiness,
- 5 and introduce students to career opportunities within the
- 6 local community and across this state. The health curriculum
- 7 shall include age-appropriate and research-based information
- 8 regarding the characteristics of sexually transmitted diseases.
- 9 The state board as part of accreditation standards shall adopt
- 10 curriculum definitions for implementing the program in grades
- 11 seven and eight. However, this subsection shall not apply to
- 12 the teaching of career exploration and development in nonpublic
- 13 schools.
- 14 Sec. 2. Section 256.11, subsection 5, paragraph j,
- 15 subparagraph (1), Code 2025, is amended to read as follows:
- 16 (1) One unit of health education which may include personal
- 17 health; food and nutrition; environmental health; safety and
- 18 survival skills; consumer health; family life; age-appropriate
- 19 and research-based human growth and development that
- 20 incorporates the standards established under section 279.50,
- 21 subsection 3, paragraph "b"; substance use disorder and nonuse;
- 22 emotional and social health; health resources; cardiopulmonary
- 23 resuscitation; and prevention and control of disease, including
- 24 age-appropriate and research-based information regarding
- 25 sexually transmitted diseases.
- Sec. 3. Section 256E.7, subsection 2, paragraph g, Code
- 27 2025, is amended by adding the following new subparagraph:
- 28 NEW SUBPARAGRAPH. (01) The educational standards of
- 29 section 256.11 relating to the human growth and development
- 30 curriculum for grades four through eight or the health
- 31 curriculum for grades nine through twelve.
- 32 Sec. 4. Section 256F.4, subsection 2, Code 2025, is amended
- 33 by adding the following new paragraph:
- NEW PARAGRAPH. r. Be subject to and comply with the
- 35 requirements of section 256.11 relating to the human growth and

- 1 development curriculum for grades four through eight and the
- 2 health curriculum for grades nine through twelve.
- 3 Sec. 5. Section 279.50, subsections 2 and 3, Code 2025, are
- 4 amended to read as follows:
- 5 2. a. Subject to section 279.80, each school board shall
- 6 provide age-appropriate and research-based instruction in
- 7 human growth and development including instruction regarding
- 8 self-esteem, stress management, interpersonal relationships,
- 9 and domestic abuse in grades one through six.
- 10 b. In grades four through six, the age-appropriate and
- 11 research-based instruction in human growth and development
- 12 described in paragraph "a" shall include all of the following:
- 13 (1) Instruction related to human development inside the
- 14 womb.
- 15 (2) A high-definition ultrasound video showing the presence
- 16 of the brain, heart, and other vital organs in early fetal
- 17 development.
- 18 (3) A high-quality, computer-generated rendering or
- 19 animation, or an ultrasound or other real image, that depicts
- 20 the humanity of the unborn child by showing prenatal human
- 21 development, starting at fertilization, noting significant
- 22 markers in cell growth and organ development throughout every
- 23 stage of pregnancy.
- 24 c. The state board of education shall adopt rules pursuant
- 25 to chapter 17A to administer and interpret this subsection.
- 26 3. a. Each school board shall provide age-appropriate and
- 27 research-based instruction in human growth and development
- 28 including instruction regarding human sexuality, self-esteem,
- 29 stress management, interpersonal relationships, domestic abuse,
- 30 and the prevention and control of disease, including sexually
- 31 transmitted diseases as required in section 256.11, in grades
- 32 seven through twelve.
- 33 b. The age-appropriate and research-based instruction in
- 34 human growth and development described in paragraph "a" shall
- 35 include all of the following:

- 1 (1) Instruction related to human development inside the 2 womb.
- 3 (2) A high-definition ultrasound video showing the presence
- 4 of the brain, heart, and other vital organs in early fetal
- 5 development.
- 6 (3) A high-quality, computer-generated rendering or
- 7 animation, or an ultrasound or other real image, that depicts
- 8 the humanity of the unborn child by showing prenatal human
- 9 development, starting at fertilization, noting significant
- 10 markers in cell growth and organ development throughout every
- 11 stage of pregnancy.
- 12 c. The state board of education shall adopt rules pursuant
- 13 to chapter 17A to administer and interpret this subsection.
- 14 Sec. 6. Section 279.50, subsection 10, paragraph b, Code
- 15 2025, is amended to read as follows:
- 16 b. "Research-based" means all of the following:
- 17 (1) Complete complete, unbiased information that is
- 18 verified or supported by the weight of research conducted
- 19 in compliance with accepted scientific methods +, recognized
- 20 as medically accurate and objective by leading professional
- 21 organizations and agencies with relevant expertise in the
- 22 field, such as the American college of obstetricians and
- 23 gynecologists, the American public health association, the
- 24 American academy of pediatrics, and the national association of
- 25 school nurses; and published in peer-reviewed journals where
- 26 appropriate.
- 27 (2) Information that is free of racial, ethnic, sexual
- 28 orientation, and gender biases.
