A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the enforcement of immigration laws, and
- 2 providing penalties.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. **27A.12 Failure to comply.**

2 1. Any law enforcement officer, including an elected
3 sheriff, who knowingly and intentionally fails to comply
4 with the requirements of this chapter shall be subject to
5 investigation by the attorney general as provided in section
6 27A.8.

7 2. A law enforcement officer subject to investigation
8 under subsection 1 shall be given the opportunity to comply
9 with the requirements of this chapter. Upon a determination
10 by the attorney general that a complaint submitted pursuant
11 to subsection 1 alleging a violation of this section is
12 valid, a law enforcement officer refusing to comply with the
13 requirements of this chapter may have the officer's case
14 referred to the Iowa law enforcement academy council, pursuant
15 to section 80B.13A, with a recommendation for revocation of the
16 officer's certification.
