ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to Colbert County; to establish the Colbert County Community Development Commission; to provide for the membership of the commission; and to establish a Community Development Fund within the county treasury and provide for the source of revenue.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) The Colbert County Community Development Commission is hereby created. The commission may receive and by majority vote distribute any funds in the Community Development Fund created pursuant to subsection (d) for the purposes of promoting economic development, education, recreation, including, but not limited to, community centers, conservation, and fire protection. The commission may also expend funds for the purposes authorized in Section 29-2-120, Code of Alabama 1975.

(b) The commission shall be comprised of the following members:

(1) The Judge of Probate of Colbert County, who shall serve as an ex officio member, or his or her designee whose term shall coincide with the term of the judge of probate.

1 (2) A person appointed by each Senator representing
2 Colbert County whose term shall coincide with the term of the
3 Senator or until a replacement is appointed.

4 (3) A person appointed by each member of the House
5 of Representatives representing a portion of Colbert County
6 whose term shall coincide with the term of the representative
7 or until a replacement is appointed.

8 (c) The commission may promulgate rules related to
9 its operations and procedures for the awarding of grants
10 within the community for the above mentioned purposes.

11 (d) The Community Development Fund is created within
12 the Colbert County treasury. The fund shall be comprised of
13 the additional three percent of TVA in-lieu-of tax payments
14 received pursuant to Act 2006-655 beginning with the fiscal
15 year which began October 1, 2006. These funds shall be
16 expended on order of the Colbert County Community Development
17 Commission.

18 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
19 first day of the third month following its passage and
20 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
