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6 ENROLLED, An Act,

7 To establish the DeKalb County Community Development
8 Commission; to provide for the membership of the Commission;
9 and to establish a Community Development Fund within the
10 county treasury and provide for the source of revenue.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

12 Section 1. There is hereby created the DeKalb County
13 Community Development Commission which shall be authorized to
14 receive and by majority vote to distribute any funds in the
15 Community Development Fund created herein for the purposes of
16 promoting economic development, education, conservation, and
17 fire protection. The Commission shall be comprised of the
18 following members:

19 (1) the probate judge of DeKalb County or his
20 designee whose term shall coincide with the term of the
21 probate judge.

22 (2) a person appointed by the Senator representing
23 DeKalb County whose term will coincide with the term of the
24 Senator or until replacement.

1 (3) A person appointed by the House of
2 Representatives member who represents a majority of the
3 population of DeKalb County whose term shall coincide with the
4 term of the representative or until replacement.

5 The Commission may promulgate rules and regulations
6 related to its operations and procedures for the awarding of
7 grants within the community for the above mentioned purposes.

8 There is hereby created the Community Development
9 Fund within the DeKalb County treasury. The fund shall be
10 comprised of the following receipts:

11 (1) the additional 3% of TVA in-lieu-of tax payments
12 received pursuant to Act 2006-655 beginning with the fiscal
13 year which began October 1, 2006.

14 (2) the net proceeds of the state beer tax payable
15 to DeKalb County pursuant to Section 28-3-190, Code of Alabama
16 1975.

17 These funds shall be expended on order of the DeKalb
18 County Community Development Commission.

19 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
20 first day of the third month following its passage and
21 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
