6 ENROLLED, An Act,

7 Relating to Colbert County; to establish the Colbert
8 County Community Development Commission; to provide for the
9 membership of the commission; and to establish a Community
10 Development Fund within the county treasury and provide for
11 the source of revenue.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

13 Section 1. (a) The Colbert County Community
14 Development Commission is hereby created. The commission may
15 receive and by majority vote distribute any funds in the
16 Community Development Fund created pursuant to subsection (d)
17 for the purposes of promoting economic development, education,
18 recreation, including, but not limited to, community centers,
19 conservation, and fire protection. The commission may also
20 expend funds for the purposes authorized in Section 29-2-120,
21 Code of Alabama 1975.

22 (b) The commission shall be comprised of the
23 following members:

24 (1) The Judge of Probate of Colbert County, who
25 shall serve as an ex officio member, or his or her designee

1 whose term shall coincide with the term of the judge of
2 probate.

3 (2) A person appointed by each Senator representing
4 Colbert County whose term shall coincide with the term of the
5 Senator or until a replacement is appointed.

6 (3) A person appointed by each member of the House
7 of Representatives representing a portion of Colbert County
8 whose term shall coincide with the term of the representative
9 or until a replacement is appointed.

10 (c) The commission may promulgate rules related to
11 its operations and procedures for the awarding of grants
12 within the community for the above mentioned purposes.

13 (d) The Community Development Fund is created within
14 the Colbert County treasury. The fund shall be comprised of
15 the additional three percent of TVA in-lieu-of tax payments
16 received pursuant to Act 2006-655 beginning with the fiscal
17 year which began October 1, 2006. These funds shall be
18 expended on order of the Colbert County Community Development
19 Commission.

20 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
21 first day of the third month following its passage and
22 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
