AN ACT in relation to authorizing the town of Schroepfel to  
repay to  
taxpayers monies erroneously received by such town as a  
result of  
overpaid special assessments

**The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate  
and Assem-**

**bly, do enact as follows:**

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the  
contrary, the  
2 town of Schroepfel, county of Oswego, is hereby authorized and  
directed  
3 to refund or credit monies erroneously received by such town as  
a result  
4 of special assessments collected pursuant to the 2005  
assessment roll  
5 which was prepared on the basis of erroneous budget figures  
used to fund  
6 water district #1, water district #2, water district #3  
and sewer  
7 district #2 within such town. Such monies erroneously received  
and to be  
8 repaid by the town of Schroepfel shall be any monies  
collected by the  
9 county of Oswego for such town and received by such town  
above the  
10 amount of monies desired to be received by such town for  
each such

11 district, as set forth in the following table:
