#### RELATING TO STATE AFFAIRS AND GOVERNMENT -- PRIZES AND GIFTS

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 42-61.1 of the General Laws entitled "Prizes and Gift Act" is
- 2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>42-61.1-10. Fishing tournaments prize regulations. (a) All fishing tournaments that</u>
- 4 require a fee for participation and offer prizes of cash or monetary value shall be subject to the
- 5 <u>following requirements in addition to all other requirements provided in this chapter:</u>
- 6 (1) All advertising shall clearly state what the requirements are to win the contest.
- 7 (2) The rules for the tournament shall be fair to participants and not make it unreasonably
- 8 difficult to meet the condition for the prize and all prizes payout for rules shall be clearly
- 9 <u>explained.</u>
- 10 (3) If a fishing tournament uses polygraph tests:
- 11 (i) The use of polygraph tests shall be conducted in the state of Rhode Island at a time
- 12 and place that all participants can reasonably make at the time of the tournament or within several
- 13 <u>hours after the end of the tournament;</u>
- 14 (ii) All polygraph experts shall be certified and be required to sign an affidavit to confirm
- 15 that they will conduct an objective test and have not been asked to influence the outcome;
- 16 (iii) The polygraph tests shall be conducted according to accepted and customary
- 17 polygraph standards and procedures; and
- 18 (iv) The test results shall be provided to the participants and they shall have a reasonable
- 19 period to review the results and retake another test at their own expense if they choose.

- 1 (4) Tournament operatives shall verify all final prize payments and places of finish.
- 2 (5) Tournament operatives shall be required to distribute copies of all Rhode Island
- 3 <u>fishing regulations relating to the tournament to all participants.</u>
- 4 (b) In any civil action alleging a violation of this section, the court may:
- 5 (1) Award punitive damages to a prevailing fishing tournament entrant in addition to any
- 6 <u>award of actual damages;</u>
- 7 (2) Award reasonable attorneys' fees and costs to a prevailing fishing tournament entrant;
- 8 <u>and</u>
- 9 (3) Award injunctive relief against any tournament operative who commits or proposes to
- 10 <u>commit a violation of this section.</u>
- 11 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
