- 4 <u>2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, an unremarried</u> spouse
- 5 of an employee of the state who retired prior to April first, nineteen
- 6 hundred seventy-nine and deceased subsequent to such retirement, and
- 7 such spouse having been determined to be eligible for continued coverage

  FISCAL NOTE.--There are currently 1,600 pre-'79 dependent survivors of

whom 1,467 pay full share and 133 are "amended" dependent survivors who pay 25% of the cost of dependent coverage in accordance with a previous legislated modification that affected these dependent survivors. There are 10,247 post '79 dependent survivors who pay the same rate as active employees for the coverage/option elected. Based on only the actual number of pre-79 survivors now enrolled, the cost of bringing the State's contribution on behalf of pre-79 dependent survivors up to the current dependent survivor contribution rate is \$7,500,000. This is an annual cost based upon current rates. The added cost of bringing the cost of pre-79 dependent survivors up to the current dependent survivor coverage expressed as a percentage of EXPLANATION--Matter in italics (underscored) is new; matter in brackets [-] is old law to be omitted.
