RELATING TO ELECTIONS -- REGISTRATION OF VOTERS

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 17-9.1 of the General Laws entitled "Registration of Voters" is
2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 **17-9.1-33. Age. –** (a) Every person who has reached the age of eighteen (18) years or
4 who is seventeen (17) years of age and will be eighteen (18) years of age by the date of the next
5 election, and is otherwise qualified to register may do so for that election.

6 (b) A person who is otherwise qualified to register and is at least sixteen (16) years of age
7 but will not be eighteen (18) years of age by the date of the next election may preregister upon
8 satisfactory proof of age and shall be automatically registered upon reaching age eighteen (18).

9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
