This bill provides one-time General Fund for maintenance and improvements at parks across the state and also provides funding for seven Line Items, three of which are funded principally by the General Fund. Those three Line Items include the purchase of a land parcel adjacent to Ritter Island on the Snake River near Hagerman, funding for a bridge at Eagle Island State Park, and funding for the purchase of land on the Snake River between Blackfoot and Firth for a new State Park in Eastern Idaho.
