AN ACT concerning local government.

## 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by 5 changing Section 8-3-14 as follows:

6 (65 ILCS 5/8-3-14) (from Ch. 24, par. 8-3-14)

7 Sec. 8-3-14. The corporate authorities of any municipality may impose a tax upon all persons engaged in such municipality 8 9 in the business of renting, leasing or letting rooms in a hotel, as defined in "The Hotel Operators' Occupation Tax Act," 10 at a rate not to exceed 6% in the City of East Peoria and in the 11 12 Village of Morton and 5% in all other municipalities of the 13 gross rental receipts from such renting, leasing or letting, 14 excluding, however, from gross rental receipts, the proceeds of such renting, leasing or letting to permanent residents of that 15 16 hotel and proceeds from the tax imposed under subsection (c) of 17 Section 13 of the Metropolitan Pier and Exposition Authority Act, and may provide for the administration and enforcement of 18 19 the tax, and for the collection thereof from the persons 20 subject to the tax, as the corporate authorities determine to 21 be necessary or practicable for the effective administration of 22 the tax.

1 granted by this Section may reimburse themselves for their tax
2 liability for such tax by separately stating such tax as an
3 additional charge, which charge may be stated in combination,
4 in a single amount, with State tax imposed under "The Hotel
5 Operators' Occupation Tax Act".

Nothing in this Section shall be construed to authorize a municipality to impose a tax upon the privilege of engaging in any business which under the constitution of the United States may not be made the subject of taxation by this State.

10 The amounts collected by any municipality pursuant to this 11 Section shall be expended by the municipality solely to promote 12 tourism and conventions within that municipality or otherwise 13 to attract nonresident overnight visitors to the municipality.

No funds received pursuant to this Section shall be used to advertise for or otherwise promote new competition in the hotel business.
