1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to repeal the ban on certain medical research and to provide
2 certain limitations for human embryonic stem cell research.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 34-14-18 be repealed.

5 ~~34-14-18. No person may use for research purposes cells or tissues that the person knows~~
6 ~~were obtained by performing the activities described in §§ 34-14-16 and 34-14-17. A violation~~
7 ~~of this section is a Class 1 misdemeanor.~~

8 Section 2. That chapter 34-14 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
9 follows:

10 No human embryonic stem cell research may be conducted unless the stem cell lines used
11 in the research were derived prior to 9:00 p.m. EDT on August 9, 2001, and are listed on the
12 human embryonic stem cell registry established by the National Institutes of Health.
