AN ACT

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 44:5, relative to public records; to provide for the application of
3	laws relative to public records; and to provide for related matters.
4	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
5	Section 1. R.S. 44:5 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
6	§5. Records in custody of the governor
7	A. This Chapter shall not apply to any of the books, records, writings,
8	accounts, letters, letter books, photographs, or copies thereof ordinarily kept in the
9	custody or control of the governor in the usual course of the duties and business of
10	his office, or to those having been used, being in use, or prepared, possessed, or
11	retained for use by or on behalf of the governor in the usual course of the duties and
12	business of his office relating to the deliberative process of the governor, intra-
13	office communications of the governor and his internal staff, the governor's
14	security and schedule, or communications with or the security and schedule of
15	the governor's spouse or children.
16	B. The (1) Except as otherwise provided in this Subsection, the provisions
17	of this Section shall not apply to any agency, office, or department transferred or
18	placed within the office of the governor.
19	(2) Notwithstanding Paragraph (1) of this Subsection, a record limited
20	to pre-decisional advice and recommendations to the governor concerning
21	budgeting in the custody of any agency or department headed by an unclassified
22	gubernatorial appointee shall be privileged for six months from the date such
23	record is prepared.
24	C. The provisions of this Section shall not prevent any person otherwise
25	herein authorized so to do from examining and copying any books, records, papers

accounts or other documents pertaining to any money or monies or any financial 2 transactions in the control of or handled by or through the governor. 3 **D.** For purposes of this Section: 4 (1) "Deliberative process" means the process by which decisions and 5 policies are formulated. (2) Records "relating to the deliberative process of the governor" means 6 7 all forms of pre-decisional advice, opinions, deliberations, or recommendations made for the purpose of assisting the governor in the usual course of the duties 8 9 and business of his office. 10 (3) "Internal staff of the governor" means the governor, chief of staff, executive counsel, director of policy, and employees under their supervision. 11 12 Internal staff shall not mean any person employed in any other executive 13 agency, including those designated by state law as housed in or transferred to 14 the office of the governor. 15 E. Notwithstanding any provision of this Chapter, the state police shall maintain a travel log identifying the date and location of all travel by the 16 17 governor in a state police helicopter, which record shall be available for 18 inspection and copying in accordance with the provisions of this Chapter. Entries to the state police helicopter travel log shall be made within seven days 19 20 after the date of travel.
