HOUSE BILL NO. 409 (As Passed the House)

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-2-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO DELETE THE PROVISIONS THAT PERMIT A FINE TO BE IMPOSED FOR A 2. (1) A violation of this chapter shall be a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) 10 upon conviction; however, only the operator of a vehicle may be 11 fined for a violation of this chapter by the operator, for a 12 violation of this chapter by a front seat passenger or for a 13 14 violation of this chapter by a child who is at least four (4) years of age but under eight (8) years of age, regardless of the 15 seat that the child occupies * * *. The maximum fine that may be 16 imposed against the operator of a vehicle for a violation of this 17 chapter by the operator or for a violation of this chapter by one 18 19 or more passengers shall be Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) in the

21 (2) A violation of this chapter shall not be entered on the 22 driving record of any individual so convicted, nor shall any state assessment provided for by Section 99-19-73, or any other state 23 24 law, be imposed or collected.
