A RESOLUTION

1 Relative to adjournment; and for other purposes.

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that, unless otherwise
3 provided by subsequent resolution of the General Assembly, the meeting dates and dates of
4 adjournment for the 2010 regular session of the General Assembly for the period of
5 Thursday, February 18, 2010, through Monday, March 15, 2010, shall be as follows:

6 Thursday, February 18..... in session for legislative day 20

7 Friday, February 19 through Sunday, March 7. in adjournment

8 Monday, March 8..... in session for legislative day 21

9 Tuesday, March 9. in session for legislative day 22

10 Wednesday, March 10..... in session for legislative day 23

11 Thursday, March 11..... in session for legislative day 24

12 Friday, March 12, through Sunday, March 14..... in adjournment

13 Monday, March 15..... in session for legislative day 25

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that on and after March 15, 2010, the periods of adjournment
15 of the 2010 session, if any, shall be as specified by subsequent resolution of the General
16 Assembly.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the joint session previously scheduled by HR 1433 for
18 February 24, 2010, for the purpose of hearing a message from the Chief Justice of the
19 Supreme Court shall be rescheduled at a later date and the Secretary of the Senate shall
20 transmit a copy of this resolution to the Chief Justice, to each other Justice of the Supreme
21 Court, and to each Judge of the Court of Appeals.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the provisions of this resolution shall control over and
23 supersede those of HR 1262 which shall be of no further force or effect.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, as authorized by Code Section 28-1-2, the hours for
25 closing and convening the Senate on each day may be as ordered by the Senate; and the
26 hours for closing and convening the House on each day may be as ordered by the House.
