HOUSE BILL NO. 95

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 21 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO MOTORCYCLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

- 1 Section 1. Amend §4185(b), Title 21 of the Delaware Code by deleting the language “shall have in that person's
- 2 possession a safety helmet approved by the Secretary of Safety and Homeland Security (hereinafter “Secretary”) through
- 3 the Office of Highway Safety and” as it appears in subsection (b).

SYNOPSIS

This bill eliminates the requirement that a person must have a safety helmet in their possession while operating or riding on a motorcycle. This bill does not change the requirement in Title 21 of the Delaware Code that a person up to 19 years of age must wear a safety helmet while operating or riding on a motorcycle.
