Such The district shall be is operated, managed, 24 and governed by a commission, to be known as 'Berea Water and Sewer Public Service District Commission'. The commission 25 26 shall consist of three five resident electors of the district who shall 27 be appointed by the Governor, upon the recommendation of a 28 majority of the Legislative Delegation of Greenville County, 29 including the Senator. The original appointments shall must be for a term of two years for one appointee, for four years for the second 30 31 appointee, and for six years for the third appointee, and in all cases 32 those persons holding office shall continue to hold office until their 33 successors have been appointed and have qualified. After 34 appointment, the commissioners shall draw lots to determine who 35 shall serve the various terms. All of the terms shall begin on the 36 effective date of this act. Upon the termination of office of anya 37 commissioner, a successor shall must be elected by the qualified electors of the district. Any A vacancy occurring in the office of a 38 39 commissioner by reason of death, resignation, or otherwise, 40 shallmust be filled for the remainder of the unexpired term by 41 appointment of the Governor, upon the recommendation of a

4 SECTION 2. The two members of the Berea Public Service 5 District Commission added by the provisions of SECTION 1 of 6 this act must be initially appointed by the Governor upon 7 recommendation of a majority of the Greenville County 8 Legislative Delegation, including the Senator, and will be seated as 9 of July first of the year in which the act is approved for terms of 10 one and one-half and three and one-half years to be determined by 11 lot. At the expiration of those two terms, they must be elected for 12 terms of six years each by the qualified electors residing in the 13 Berea Public Service District.
