JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 201

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION TO REDISTRICT THE MISSISSIPPI STATE
2 SENATE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF
4 MISSISSIPPI, That the number of Senators shall be fifty-two (52)
5 and shall be elected from fifty-two (52) districts, composed as

430 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That partial or split precincts
431 contained in this resolution are identified in this joint
432 resolution by an asterisk (*) which shall precede its designation
433 within the description of a district.

434 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chairman and Vice Chairman
435 of the Standing Joint Legislative Committee on Reapportionment
436 shall file with the Secretary of State the Split Precinct Block
437 List developed in conjunction with the plan contained in this
438 joint resolution that details the portions of the partial or split
439 precincts that are contained within a district by census tract and
440 block number, and such document duly filed with the Secretary of
441 State is hereby incorporated into and shall be construed to be an
442 integral part of this joint resolution.

443 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the boundaries of the senatorial
444 districts described above shall be:

445 (a) The boundaries of the counties listed above as such
446 boundaries existed as of January 1, 2010; and

447 (b) The boundaries of the precincts, census tracts and
448 blocks listed above as such boundaries are contained in the Census
449 2010 Tiger/Line Shapefiles released November 2010.



450 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution shall be
451 liberally construed to effectuate the purposes thereof and to
452 redistrict the Senate of this state in compliance with
453 constitutional requirements.

454 It is intended that this resolution and the districts
455 described herein completely encompass all the area within the
456 state. It is also intended that such districts contain all the
457 inhabitants in this state. It is further intended that the
458 redistricting provided for in this resolution result in the
459 creation of districts which are substantially equal in population.
460 It is also intended that no district shall include any of the area
461 included within the description of any other district.

462 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That if the districts described in
463 this resolution do not carry out the purposes thereof, because of
464 unintentional omissions; duplications; overlapping areas;
465 erroneous nomenclature; lack of adequate maps or descriptions of
466 political subdivisions, wards or other divisions thereof, or of
467 their boundary lines, then the Secretary of State, at the request
468 of the Chair of the Senate Elections Committee shall, by order,
469 correct such omissions, overlaps, erroneous nomenclature or other
470 defects in the description of districts so as to accomplish the
471 purposes and objectives of this resolution.

472 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That in promulgating such orders, the
473 Secretary of State, in addition to achieving equality in the
474 population of districts and insuring that all areas of the state
475 are completely and accurately encompassed in such districts, shall
476 be guided by the following standards:

477 (a) In any instance in which there is a conflict
478 between the description of a district as set out in this
479 resolution and the map of the Senate Districts developed by the
480 Standing Joint Legislative Committee on Reapportionment in
481 conjunction with the adopted redistricting plan, the map shall
482 control; however, in instances in which the map is inconclusive,



the criteria set out in paragraphs (b) through (f) shall control the resolution of any dispute or issue regarding the composition of any Senate District;

(b) Gaps in the description of any district shall be completed in a manner which results in a total description of that district in a manner which is consonant with the description of adjacent districts and results in complete contiguity of districts;

(c) Areas of the state included within the descriptions of more than one (1) district shall be allocated to the district having the lowest population;

(d) Areas of the state not included within the descriptions of any district shall be allocated to the adjacent district having the lowest population;

(e) In the event that the area subject to corrected description or allocation as provided in paragraphs (b), (c) and (d) of this clause is of such size or contains such population that its inclusion as a unit in any district would result in substantial disparity in the size, shape or population of such district, then the Secretary of State may allocate portions of such area to two (2) or more districts; and

(f) In any allocation of area or correction of descriptions made pursuant to this resolution, the Secretary of State shall, consistent with the foregoing standards, preserve the contiguity and compactness of districts and avoid the unnecessary division of political subdivisions.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of such orders shall be filed by the Secretary of State in his own office and in the offices of the affected commissioners of election and registrars. The Secretary of State may adopt reasonable rules regulating the procedure for applications for orders under this resolution in the manner of serving and filing any notice or copy of orders relating thereto. Upon the filing of such an order, the description of any



516 affected district shall be deemed to have been corrected in the
517 manner provided in such order to the full extent as if such
518 correction had been contained in the original description set
519 forth in this resolution.

520 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Standing Joint Legislative
521 Committee on Reapportionment is directed to provide all
522 information necessary to assist the counties in identifying the
523 boundaries of the districts described in this resolution.

524 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the redistricting contained in
525 this resolution shall supersede any prior redistricting, and any
526 prior redistricting shall be null and void upon the date this
527 resolution is effectuated.

528 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution shall be placed
529 in the editor's notes that follow Section 5-1-3, Mississippi Code
530 of 1972.

531 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That if any paragraph, sentence,
532 clause, phrase or any part of this resolution is declared to be
533 unconstitutional or void or if for any reason is declared to be
534 invalid or of no effect, the remaining paragraphs, sentences,
535 clauses, phrases or parts thereof shall be in no manner affected
536 thereby but shall remain in full force and effect.

537 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chairman of the Senate
538 Elections Committee, with the assistance of counsel employed by
539 the Standing Joint Legislative Committee on Reapportionment, is
540 hereby directed to submit this resolution, immediately upon its
541 adoption by both houses of the Legislature, to the Attorney
542 General of the United States or to the United States District
543 Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the
544 provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and
545 extended.

546 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution shall take
547 effect and be in force from and after the date it is finally



548 effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as
549 amended and extended.
