1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 47:551.1, relative to local taxes; to authorize the parishes of Calcasieu,
3	Jefferson, and Orleans to establish an automobile rental tax district which shall be
4	authorized to levy a local tax on the gross proceeds derived from the lease or rental
5	of an automobile pursuant to an automobile rental contract; to require approval of the
6	electorate of the district; to provide for the boundaries, governance, and powers of
7	such districts; to provide for the use of the avails of the tax; and to provide for related
8	matters.
9	Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published.
10	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
11	Section 1. R.S. 47:551.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
12	§551.1. Automobile rental tax district; parishes of Calcasieu, Jefferson, and
13	<u>Orleans</u>
14	A.(1) The governing authorities of the parishes of Calcasieu, Jefferson,
15	and Orleans may each create, by ordinance, an automobile rental tax district,
16	referred to in this Section as the "district". The district shall be a political
17	subdivision of the state as defined in the Constitution of Louisiana.
18	(2) The boundaries of the district shall be coterminous with the
19	boundaries of the parish creating the district.
20	(3) The parish governing authority creating the district shall be the
21	governing authority of the district.
22	B.(1)(a) The district is authorized to levy, beginning July 1, 2012, an
23	automobile rental tax not to exceed three percent of the gross proceeds derived
24	from the lease or rental of an automobile pursuant to an automobile rental
25	contract, less any sales and use tax included in such contract. The tax shall be

in addition to any tax, fee, or license imposed directly or indirectly.

2	(b) The tax shall be levied only after the question of its levy has been
3	approved by a majority of the registered voters of the district who vote on the
4	proposition authorizing the tax at an election held for that purpose in
5	accordance with the Louisiana Election Code. The election on the question of
6	the levy of the tax shall be held at the same time as a regularly scheduled
7	election in the parish creating the district.
8	(c) The tax shall not apply to any automobile rented by an insurance
9	company as a replacement vehicle for a policyholder or by an automobile dealer
10	as a replacement vehicle while a customer's vehicle is being serviced or
11	repaired, nor shall the tax apply to any individual or business who rents a
12	vehicle as a replacement vehicle while his vehicle is being repaired if the
13	individual presents to the renter upon return of the rented vehicle a copy of the
14	repair or service invoice.
15	(2) For purposes of this Section "automobile rental contract" shall mean
16	all agreements for the rental of an automobile, without a driver, designated to
17	carry less than nine passengers for a period of not more than twenty-nine
18	calendar days. Rental agreements for a period of more than twenty-nine
19	calendar days shall not be subject to the tax, unless the actual period of the
20	rental agreement is not more than twenty-nine days as a result of the exercise
21	of a cancellation clause.
22	C.(1) The avails of the tax in Jefferson Parish shall be distributed as
23	follows:
24	(a) One-third of the total taxes collected shall be distributed to the city
25	of Kenner for arts and recreation.
26	(b) Two-thirds of the total taxes collected shall be disbursed as follows:
27	(i) Four-twelfths to the Westwego Performing Arts Center.
28	(ii) Three-twelfths to the Jefferson Performing Arts Society for
29	programs on the east and west bank.
30	(iii) Two-twelfths to the Gretna Cultural Center for the Arts.

1	(iv) All remaining monies shall be deposited into a dedicated funding
2	account to be used exclusively for the operation, administration, and
3	maintenance of cultural facilities in unincorporated areas of Jefferson Parish.
4	(2) The avails of the tax in Orleans Parish shall be used for road repairs,
5	beautification projects, and to the Orleans Parish Council on Aging to be used
6	for Senior Centers.
7	(3) The avails of the tax in the parish of Calcasieu shall be distributed
8	as follows:
9	(a) One-sixth of the avails shall be distributed to political subdivisions
10	in the parish as provided in R.S. 47:551(D)(2).
11	(b) Five-sixth of the avails shall be distributed to Airport District No. 1
12	of Calcasieu Parish for the maintenance and operation of the Lake Charles
13	Regional Airport.
14	D. The parish governing authority creating the district shall prescribe
15	in the ordinance creating the district any other purposes of the district. The
16	parish that created the district and the district may enter into a cooperative
17	endeavor agreement providing for cooperative efforts to exercise any authorized
