**SYNOPSIS**

Supplemental appropriation to DHSS for \$7,453,000 for family planning services, and requires filing of State Plan Amendment to extend Medicaid coverage for family planning services to persons with incomes up to 200% of federal poverty level.

6 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and the General Assembly of the

9 1. In addition to the amounts appropriated under P.L.<sup>1</sup>[2010]  
10 2011<sup>1</sup>, c.<sup>1</sup>[35] 85<sup>1</sup>, there is appropriated out of the General Fund

23 The Department of Human Services shall submit a State Plan  
24 Amendment to the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid

26 persons with incomes up to 200% of the federal poverty level.
