SUBSTITUTE FOR

SENATE BILL NO. 288

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending sections 40103, 40110, 40113a, and 43536a (MCL 324.40103, 324.40110, 324.40113a, and 324.43536a), section 40103 as amended by 2012 PA 520, section 40110 as added by 1995 PA 57, section 40113a as amended by 1997 PA 19, and section 43536a as amended by 2004 PA 545, and by adding section 48703a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 40103. (1) "Game" means any ANIMAL DESIGNATED AS GAME
 UNDER SECTION 40110 AND ANY of the following animals but does not
 include privately owned cervidae species located on a cervidae
 livestock facility registered under the privately owned cervidae
 producers marketing act, 2000 PA 190, MCL 287.951 to 287.969:

14 (2) "Interim order of the department" means an order of the15 department issued under section 40108.

16 (3) "Kind" means an animal's sex, age, or physical

17 characteristics.

18 (4) "Normal agricultural practices" means generally accepted
19 agricultural and management practices as defined by the commission
20 of agriculture and rural development.

(5) "Open season" means the dates during which game may belegally taken.

23 (6) "Parts" means any or all portions of an animal, including24 the skin, plumage, hide, fur, entire body, or egg of an animal.

(7) "Protected" or "protected animal" means an animal or kind
of animal that is designated by the department as an animal that
shall not be taken.

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(8) "Residence" means a permanent building serving as a
 temporary or permanent home. Residence may include a cottage,
 cabin, or mobile home, but does not include a structure designed
 primarily for taking game, a tree blind, a tent, a recreational or
 other vehicle, or a camper.

6 Sec. 40110. (1) Only the legislature OR THE COMMISSION may 7 designate a species as game. If an animal is designated under this section by the legislature OR COMMISSION as game, then only the 8 9 legislature OR COMMISSION may authorize the establishment of the first open season for that animal. ONLY THE LEGISLATURE MAY REMOVE 10 11 A SPECIES FROM THE LIST OF GAME. THE COMMISSION SHALL EXERCISE ITS 12 AUTHORITY UNDER THIS SUBSECTION BY ISSUING ORDERS. THE COMMISSION SHALL NOT DESIGNATE ANY OF THE FOLLOWING AS GAME UNDER THIS 13 14 SUBSECTION:

15 (A) A DOMESTIC ANIMAL.

16 (B) LIVESTOCK.

17 (C) ANY SPECIES ADDED TO THE GAME LIST BY A PUBLIC ACT THAT IS
18 REJECTED BY A REFERENDUM BEFORE THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE 2013
19 AMENDATORY ACT THAT AMENDED THIS SECTION.

20 (2) After the legislature OR COMMISSION authorizes the
21 establishment of the first open season for game pursuant to this
22 section, the department may issue orders pertaining to that animal
23 for each of the purposes listed in section 40107.

24 (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:

(A) "DOMESTIC ANIMAL" MEANS THOSE SPECIES OF ANIMALS THAT LIVE
UNDER THE HUSBANDRY OF HUMANS.

27 (B) "LIVESTOCK" INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, CATTLE,

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SHEEP, NEW WORLD CAMELIDS, GOATS, BISON, PRIVATELY OWNED CERVIDS,
 RATITES, SWINE, EQUINE, POULTRY, AND RABBITS. LIVESTOCK DOES NOT
 INCLUDE DOGS AND CATS.

Sec. 40113a. (1) The legislature finds and declares that:

5 (a) The wildlife populations of the state and their habitat6 are of paramount importance to the citizens of this state.

7 (b) The sound scientific management of the wildlife
8 populations of the state, including hunting of bear, is declared to
9 be in the public interest.

10 (c) The sound scientific management of bear populations in 11 this state is necessary to minimize human/bear encounters and to 12 prevent bears from threatening or harming humans, livestock, and 13 pets.

(2) The commission of natural resources shall have HAS the 14 15 exclusive authority to regulate the taking of game as defined in section 40103 in this state. The commission of natural resources 16 17 shall, to the greatest extent practicable, utilize principles of 18 sound scientific management in making decisions regarding the 19 taking of game. Issuance of orders by the commission of natural 20 resources regarding the taking of game shall be made following a 21 public meeting and an opportunity for public input. Not less than 22 30 days before issuing an order, the commission of natural 23 resources shall provide a copy of the order to each of the 24 following:

(a) Each member of each standing committee of the senate or
house of representatives that considers legislation pertaining to
conservation, the environment, natural resources, recreation,

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1 tourism, or agriculture.

2 (b) The chairperson of the senate appropriations committee and
3 the chairperson of the house of representatives appropriations
4 committee.

5 (c) The members of the subcommittee of the senate
6 appropriations committee and the subcommittee of the house of
7 representatives appropriations committee that consider the budget
8 of the department of natural resources.

Sec. 43536a. (1) A-SUBJECT TO ANY LOTTERY AND OTHER 9 ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS, A member of the military may obtain any 10 11 license under this part for which a lottery is not required for 12 \$1.00 FREE OF CHARGE upon presentation to a licensing agent of leave papers, duty papers, military orders, or other evidence 13 14 acceptable to the department verifying that he or she is stationed outside of this state. The license is valid for a period of up to 2 15 16 weeks designated by the member of the military but only during the 17 season in which such a license would otherwise be valid.A MEMBER OF THE MILITARY. 18

19 (2) As used in this section, "member of the military" means20 either of the following:

(a) A person described by section 43506(3)(d). who is
stationed outside this state.

23 (b) A person who meets all of the following requirements:

(i) The person is a reserve component soldier, sailor, airman,
or marine or member of the Michigan national guard and is called to
federal active duty.

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(ii) At the time the person was called to federal active duty,

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1 he or she was a resident of this state.

2 <u>(iii) The person is stationed outside this state.</u>

3 (iii) (iv) The person has maintained his or her residence in this
4 state for the purpose of obtaining a driver license or voter
5 registration, or both.

6 SEC. 48703A. THE COMMISSION HAS THE EXCLUSIVE AUTHORITY TO 7 REGULATE THE TAKING OF FISH IN THIS STATE. THE COMMISSION SHALL, TO THE GREATEST EXTENT PRACTICABLE, UTILIZE PRINCIPLES OF SOUND 8 SCIENTIFIC MANAGEMENT IN MAKING DECISIONS REGARDING THE TAKING OF 9 FISH. THE COMMISSION SHALL ISSUE ORDERS REGARDING THE TAKING OF 10 11 FISH FOLLOWING A PUBLIC MEETING AND AN OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC 12 INPUT. NOT LESS THAN 30 DAYS BEFORE ISSUING AN ORDER, THE COMMISSION SHALL PROVIDE A COPY OF THE ORDER TO EACH OF THE 13 14 FOLLOWING:

15 (A) EACH MEMBER OF EACH STANDING COMMITTEE OF THE SENATE OR
16 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES THAT CONSIDERS LEGISLATION PERTAINING TO
17 CONSERVATION, THE ENVIRONMENT, NATURAL RESOURCES, RECREATION,
18 TOURISM, OR AGRICULTURE.

(B) THE CHAIRPERSON OF THE SENATE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE AND
 THE CHAIRPERSON OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES APPROPRIATIONS
 COMMITTEE.

(C) THE MEMBERS OF THE SUBCOMMITTEE OF THE SENATE
APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE AND THE SUBCOMMITTEE OF THE HOUSE OF
REPRESENTATIVES APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE THAT CONSIDER THE BUDGET
OF THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES.

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
