"8-3-3. COMPENSATION.--For the performance of the duties established in Section 8-3-1 NMSA 1978, the lieutenant governor shall receive an annual compensation of [eighty-five thousand dollars (\$85,000)] ninety-three thousand five hundred dollars <u>(\$93,500)</u>."
