6 [Oklahoma Medicaid Reform Act of 2014 - codification

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1011.13 of Title 56, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority is directed to develop
14 and implement a pilot program to evaluate the potential use of a
15 patient-centered, integrated managed care system for the provision
16 of services provided under the Oklahoma Medicaid Program. The pilot
17 program shall begin no later than January 1, 2016.

18 B. The Authority shall submit proposals for approval and seek
19 amendments or waivers of applicable federal laws and regulations
20 from the United States Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services as
21 necessary to implement the provisions of this section.

22 C. The Authority shall promulgate and adopt rules to enforce
23 the provisions of this section.

24 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
