

AN ACT relating to elections.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

➔Section 1. KRS 118.405 is amended to read as follows:

(1) No candidate's name shall appear on any voting machine or absentee ballot more than once, except that a candidate's name may appear twice if he is a candidate for a primary or a regular election and also a candidate to fill a vacancy in the same office required to be filled at a special election, when the special election to fill a vacancy is scheduled for the regular election day.

(2) *The prohibition in subsection (1) of this section shall not apply when a candidate for the office of President or Vice President of the United States of America is also a candidate for another elective office during the same primary or regular election. If the candidate is elected to the office of President or Vice President of the United States of America, such election shall void the candidate's election to any other office and such other office shall be treated as vacant.*
