ENROLLED HOUSE BILL NO. 2706

An Act relating to crimes and punishments; making certain acts unlawful; providing penalties; defining term; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Prohibited sale of compressed gas dusters

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1220.2 of Title 21, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

- A. It shall be unlawful for any person to sell a compressed gas duster to another person who is under eighteen (18) years of age. Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment in the county jail for a term of not more than one (1) year, or by a fine of not less than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.
- B. As used in this section, "compressed gas duster", also known as "compressed air" or "canned air", means a product used to clean electronic equipment or other devices that contains compressed gas such as difluoroethane, trifluoroethane or tetrafluoroethane that vaporizes prior to leaving the container.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
