RELATING TO COURT OPERATIONS; REMOVING REVERSION FROM THE MAGISTRATE COURTS OPERATIONS FUND; EXTENDING THE PERIOD DURING WHICH THE MAGISTRATE COURTS OPERATIONS FEE SHALL BE ASSESSED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 35-7-13 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2010, Chapter 7, Section 1) is amended to read:

"35-7-13. MAGISTRATE COURTS OPERATIONS

FUND--CREATED--PURPOSE.--The "magistrate courts operations fund" is created in the state treasury for appropriation by the legislature for the operations of magistrate courts. The fund consists of magistrate courts operations fees collected pursuant to Section 66-8-116.3 NMSA 1978 and any appropriations, gifts, grants and donations. Income from the fund shall be credited to the fund. Money in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not revert to any other fund."

SECTION 2. Section 66-8-116.3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1989, Chapter 318, Section 35 and Laws 1989, Chapter 319, Section 14 and also Laws 1989, Chapter 320, Section 5, as amended) is amended to read:

"66-8-116.3. PENALTY ASSESSMENT MISDEMEANORS-ADDITIONAL FEES.--In addition to the penalty assessment
established for each penalty assessment misdemeanor, there

3	twenty dollars (\$20.00) to help defray the costs of local
