It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 28-12-3 of the General Laws in Chapter 28-12 entitled "Minimum 2 Wages" is hereby amended to read as follows: 3 28-12-3. Minimum wages. -- (a) Every employer shall pay to each of his or her 4 employees: commencing July 1, 1999, at least the minimum wage of five dollars and sixty five 5 cents (\$5.65) per hour. Commencing September 1, 2000, the minimum wage is six dollars and fifteen cents (\$6.15) per hour. 6 (b) Commencing January 1, 2004, the minimum wage is six dollars and seventy-five 7 8 cents (\$6.75) per hour. 9 (c) Commencing March 1, 2006, the minimum wage is seven dollars and ten cents 10 (\$7.10) per hour. (d) Commencing January 1, 2007, the minimum wage is seven dollars and forty cents 11 12 (\$7.40) per hour. 13 (e) Commencing January 1, 2013, the minimum wage is seven dollars and seventy-five 14 cents (\$7.75) per hour. 15 (f) Commencing January 1, 2014, the minimum wage is eight dollars (\$8.00) per hour.

(g) Commencing January 1, 2015, the minimum wage is nine dollars (\$9.00) per hour.
