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1	AN ACT concerning the establishment of a common ¹ [core] ¹ course

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BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

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- 9 1. a. The Secretary of Higher Education and the New Jersey 10 President's Council, in consultation with each public institution of 11 higher education, shall develop, implement, and maintain a common 12 [core] course numbering system for general education [core] classes leading to an associate degree or a baccalaureate degree at a public institution.
 - b. The common ¹ [core] ¹ course numbering system shall be fully operational by September 1, 2016.

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2. An independent institution of higher education in the State may elect to participate in the common ¹ [core] ¹ course numbering system.

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3. This act shall take effect immediately.

EXPLANATION – Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.
