CONCERNING A PROHIBITION ON CONVERSION THERAPY BY A LICENSED

### **Bill Summary**

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill prohibits a licensed physician specializing in psychiatry and a licensed or registered mental health care provider from engaging in conversion therapy with a patient under 18 years of age. A licensee who engages in these efforts is subject to disciplinary action by the appropriate licensing board. "Conversion therapy" means efforts that seek to change an individual's sexual orientation, including efforts to change behaviors Reading Unamended March 10, 2015
