SENATE BILL 1172

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 15-1045, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO THE STUDENT
ACCOUNTABILITY INFORMATION SYSTEM.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 15-1045, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 15-1045. Education database: pupil privacy

5 A. Any collection, maintenance or disclosure of pupil educational
6 records compiled by the department of education in an education database of
7 pupil records shall comply with the family educational rights and privacy act
8 OF 1974 (20 United States Code section 1232g).

9 B. The department of education shall maintain the database in the
10 following manner:

11 1. The use of the information is limited to comply with statutory
12 obligations.

13 2. Personally identifiable information is confidential and is not A
14 public record.

15 3. Proper security measures are employed to ensure the confidentiality
16 and integrity of the education database.

17 4. Data is secured from breaches and identity theft through
18 implementation of protections and standards.

19 C. The pupil identifier in the education database is unique, ~~AND~~ not
20 identifiable by anyone other than officials maintaining the education
21 database and shall not be the pupil's social security number or any variation
22 of the pupil's social security number.

23 D. A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR CHARTER SCHOOL SHALL NOT RELEASE INFORMATION,
24 INCLUDING INFORMATION DESCRIBED AS DIRECTORY INFORMATION PURSUANT TO SECTION
25 15-142 OR INFORMATION THAT WOULD VIOLATE SECTION 15-511 OR THE FAMILY
26 EDUCATIONAL RIGHTS AND PRIVACY ACT OF 1974 (20 UNITED STATES CODE SECTION
27 1232g), TO ANY PERSON OR GROUP FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENGAGING IN POLITICAL
28 ACTIVITY, INCLUDING POLITICAL ACTIVITY RELATING TO A BOND OR OVERRIDE
29 ELECTION. A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR CHARTER SCHOOL SHALL NOT ACCEPT MONETARY
30 COMPENSATION OR GIFTS, OTHER THAN REASONABLE FEES PERMITTED BY LAW, FOR THE
31 PRODUCTION OF RECORDS OR IN RETURN FOR PROVIDING A PERSON WITH INFORMATION
32 DESCRIBED AS DIRECTORY INFORMATION PURSUANT TO SECTION 15-142 OR INFORMATION
33 THAT WOULD VIOLATE SECTION 15-511 OR THE FAMILY EDUCATIONAL RIGHTS AND
34 PRIVACY ACT OF 1974 (20 UNITED STATES CODE SECTION 1232g).
