11	TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA,
12	1976, BY ADDING ARTICLE 9 TO CHAPTER 31, TITLE 23 SO
13	AS TO ENACT THE "SECOND AMENDMENT
14	PRESERVATION ACT" AND TO PROVIDE THAT THE STATE
15	SHALL NOT ENFORCE CERTAIN LAWS, RULES, OR
	REGULATIONS THAT LIMIT THE RIGHT OF A PERSON TO
17	OWN, POSSESS, OR USE A FIREARM, AMMUNITIONS, OR
18	FIREARM ACCESSORIES, ACCEPT CERTAIN FEDERAL
19	FUNDS THAT REQUIRE FIREARMS TO BE REGISTERED OR
	CONFISCATED, OR EXPEND ANY STATE FUNDS TOWARD

28	SECTION 1. Chapter 31, Title 23 of the 1976 Code is amended by

33	Second Amendment Preservation Act
34	
35	Section 23-31-900. The General Assembly finds that the Second
36	Amendment to the United States Constitution protects an
37	individual's right to 'keep and bear arms' and further provides that
38	the right to keep and bear arms may not be infringed.
39	
40	Section 23-31-910. Notwithstanding any other provision of law,
41	the State shall not:

[4701] 1

(1) enforce any federal law, rule, or regulation that took effec
after January 1, 2016, that limits the right of a person to own
possess, or use a firearm, ammunition, or firearm accessories;
(2) accept any federal funds related to any law, rule, or
regulation that took effect after January 1, 2016, that requires
firearms to be registered or confiscated; or
(3) expend any state funds toward the enforcement of any
federal law, rule, or regulation that took effect after January 1, 2016
that requires firearms to be registered or confiscated."
