AN ACT

RELATING TO JUDGES; PROVIDING FOR AN ADDITIONAL MAGISTRATE
JUDGE IN QUAY MAGISTRATE DISTRICT; AMENDING A SECTION OF THE
NMSA 1978.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 35-1-23 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1968,
Chapter 62, Section 25, as amended) is amended to read:

"35-1-23. MAGISTRATE COURT--QUAY DISTRICT.--~~[There shall
be one magistrate in Quay magistrate district whose principal
court is in Tucumcari. The magistrate shall ride circuit to
San Jon on a regularly scheduled basis]~~ There shall be two
magistrates in Quay magistrate district, one for division 1 in
Tucumcari and one for division 2 in San Jon."

Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the
provisions of this act is January 1, 1996.



APPROPRIATION.--Thirty-five thousand six hundred twenty-three dollars (\$35,623) is appropriated from the general fund to the Quay magistrate district for expenditure in fiscal year 1996 for one additional full-time-equivalent position. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1996 shall revert to the general fund.".
4. Renumber the succeeding section accordingly.,




