17	Section 1. Section 12-5-2 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1969,
18	Chapter 114, Section 1, as amended by Laws 1987, Chapter 3,
19	Section 1 and also by Laws 1987, Chapter 309, Section 1) is

13	Section 2. [NEW MATERIAL] CESAR ESTRADA CHAVEZ
14	COMMISSION CREATED DEFINED MEMBERS TERMS COMPENSATION
15	A. The "Cesar Estrada Chavez commission" is created.
16	The purpose of the commission is to develop, promote, coordinate
17	and review statewide plans and activities for the annual
18	commemoration and celebration of the birthday of Cesar Estrada
19	Chavez in accordance with Section 12-5-2 NMSA 1978.
20	B. As used in Sections 2 through 5 of this act,
21	"commission" means the Cesar Estrada Chavez commission.
22	C. The commission shall be comprised of thirteen
23	members as follows:
24	(1) four members appointed by the governor;
25	(2) one member appointed by the president pro

2	(3) one member appointed by the minority leader			
3	of the senate;			
4	(4) one member appointed by the speaker of the			
5	house of representatives;			
6	(5) one members appointed by the minority			
7	leader of the house of representatives;			
8	(6) the state treasurer or his designee;			
9	(7) the secretary of state or his designee;			
10	(8) a Native American appointed by the New			
11	Mexico office of Indian affairs;			
12	(9) the director of the human rights division			
13	of the labor department or his designee; and			
14	(10) the chairman of the state corporation			
15	commission or his designee.			
16	D. Members of the commission shall be appointed			
17	initially for terms as follows: seven members shall be			
18	appointed for terms of two years and six members shall be			
19	appointed for terms of four years. The initial terms shall be			
20	determined by random drawing. After the expiration of the			
21	initial terms, all members shall be appointed for four-year			
22	terms. The initial commission shall be appointed within forty-			
23	five days from the effective date of this act. Vacancies			
24	resulting from the death or resignation of a member shall be			
25	filled by appointment by the commission chairman for the

unexpired portion of the term of the member creating the vacancy. In filling any vacancy, the commission chairman may accept recommendations from the person who originally appointed the member creating the vacancy.

- E. The members of the commission shall receive no compensation for their service.
- F. The members of the commission shall select a chairman from the members of the commission.
- G. The commission shall appoint an executive director to coordinate all activities on the commission's behalf.
- Section 3. [NEW MATERIAL] CESAR ESTRADA CHAVEZ FUND-CREATED.--
- A. There is created within the state treasury for the commission a fund that shall be designated as the "Cesar Estrada Chavez fund" that shall consist of appropriations, endowments and bequests.
- B. Money from the fund shall be disbursed upon warrant of the secretary of finance and administration pursuant to vouchers submitted by the executive director of the commission for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this act.
- Section 4. [NEW MATERIAL] DUTIES OF THE COMMISSION. -- The duties of the commission shall include the following:
 - A. to develop a plan for the commemoration and

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celebration of the official legal holiday honoring Cesar Estrada Chavez:

- B. to develop and submit to the governor and the legislature recommendations for specific commemorative activities to be undertaken by the state for the Cesar Estrada Chavez holiday;
- C. to coordinate state plans and activities with federal plans and activities for the commemoration and celebration of the Cesar Estrada Chavez holiday;
- D. to develop, with other agencies of the state, an interpretive program that explores the historical, social, political and cultural themes associated with the life and works of Cesar Estrada Chavez;
- E. to develop and acquire interpretive materials and publications on the significance of Cesar Estrada Chavez' work and develop a commemorative program for state employees, school children and the general public;
- F. to create a process to facilitate the implementation of the master plan project and other recommendations made by the commission;
- G. to prepare and provide to the general public advice, assistance and information on the Cesar Estrada Chavez holiday activities recommended by the commission;
- H. to submit other studies, reports and recommendations to the governor and the legislature as are

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necessary with respect to activities for the continued commemoration and celebration of Cesar Estrada Chavez; and

to accept endowments and bequests for the Cesar Estrada Chavez fund.

Section 5. COMMISSION REPORT. -- The commission shall make an initial report to the governor and the legislature of its findings, conclusions, proposals and recommendations for the observance of the Cesar Estrada Chavez holiday within ninety days of the effective date of this act. The commission shall submit an annual report of its activities to the legislature no The first annual report later than December 1 of each year. shall be submitted no later than December 1, 1997.
