- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 62.1-01 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to a restriction on firearm buyback programs; and to provide a penalty.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 62.1-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
 - Firearm buyback program Prohibited.
- 7 <u>1. As used in this section, "firearm buyback program" means a program to purchase</u>
- 8 privately owned firearms, firearm parts, or ammunition from private individuals or
- 9 <u>organizations for the purpose of providing cash, gifts, or vouchers; or reducing the</u>
- number of firearms, firearm parts, or ammunition owned by civilians; or permitting a
- civilian to sell a firearm to the government without fear of prosecution. The term does
- not include the purchase of firearms, firearm parts, or ammunition from a licensed
- firearms dealer, or a program to purchase firearms, firearm parts, or ammunition for
- 14 <u>law enforcement purposes.</u>
- 15 <u>2. A state agency, political subdivision, or any law enforcement agency of this state may</u>
- not conduct a firearm buyback program or participate in the implementation,
- 17 <u>administration, or operation of a firearm buyback program.</u>
- 18 <u>3. A state agency, political subdivision, or any law enforcement agency of this state may</u>
- not expend any taxpayer dollars for the purpose of implementing, administering, or
- otherwise operating a firearm buyback program.
- 4. A violation of this section is a class A misdemeanor.
