4 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*

7 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law, rule, or
8 regulation, lawful presence in the United States shall not be required
9 to obtain a professional or occupational license, provided that the
10 applicant meets all other requirements for licensure.
