| 12 | operations, refuses to mandate a COVID-19 vaccination or immunization for any                  |
| 13 | employee or customer.  |
| 14 | B. The state, a state agency, or a political subdivision of the state shall not                |
| 15 | refuse to permit, renew, or withhold a business license or professional license solely         |
| 16 | on the basis that the business has refused to mandate a COVID-19 vaccination or                |
| 17 | immunization for any employee or customer.   |
