AMENDING TITLE 38, CHAPTER 8, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 38-1117; RELATING TO PEACE OFFICERS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Title 38, chapter 8, article 1, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 38-1117, to read:
4 38-1117. Peace officer complaint; mandatory notice
5 BEFORE A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY ACCEPTS A COMPLAINT MADE AGAINST A
6 PEACE OFFICER, THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY MUST PROVIDE THE PERSON MAKING
7 THE COMPLAINT WITH THE FOLLOWING NOTICE:
8 PURSUANT TO SECTION 13-2907.01, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES,
9 IT IS A CLASS 1 MISDEMEANOR TO KNOWINGLY MAKE TO A LAW
10 ENFORCEMENT AGENCY A FALSE, FRAUDULENT OR UNFOUNDED REPORT
11 OR STATEMENT OR TO KNOWINGLY MISREPRESENT A FACT FOR THE
12 PURPOSE OF INTERFERING WITH THE ORDERLY OPERATION OF A LAW
13 ENFORCEMENT AGENCY OR MISLEADING A PEACE OFFICER.
