1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 72A.20, is amended by adding a subdivision

1.7 to read:

1.8 Subd. 41. Discrimination based on status as a living organ or bone marrow donor

1.9 prohibited. A life insurance, long-term care insurance, or disability insurance carrier is

1.10 prohibited from declining or limiting coverage of an insured or otherwise discriminating in

1.11 the premium rating, offering, issuance, cancellation, amount of coverage, or any other

1.12 condition based solely upon the status of an insured as a living organ or bone marrow donor

1.13 and without additional actuarial risks.

1.14 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective for insurance policies issued and renewed

1.15 on or after August 1, 2022.
