United States Presidential Candidates

This section provides office information on current major and third party presidential candidates including contact information, issue positions and campaign contributions. Candidates chosen for inclusion are the top candidate(s) from the top 4 political parties at the time of this printing.

Campaign Information

The candidates' campaign contact information includes: 1) mailing address 2) phone 3) webmail 4) website 5) Facebook and 6) Twitter. Next to each candidate's name is his or her party affiliation. Abbreviations for party affiliations are: Democratic (D), Green (G), Libertarian (L) and Republican (R).

Political Courage Test (issue positions)

The Political Courage Test asks candidates one central question: "Are you willing to tell citizens where you stand on the issues you may face if elected?" Each election, Vote Smart encourages candidates to provide this essential information to voters with letters, phone calls, and emails from our team of staff and volunteers.

Whether or not a candidate has shown political courage by telling citizens where he or she stands on the issues this election year is on the candidate's profile and inside the issue positions chart. If a candidate fails to demonstrate political courage on key questions, Vote Smart will determine the candidate's likely positions from his or her public statements, legislative record and interest group ratings.

Campaign Contributions

The following campaign finance data for U.S. Presidential candidates was provided by the Center for Responsive Politics (www.opensecrets.org). This data only includes the contributions made to presidential campaigns as reported to the Federal Elections Commission (FEC); if a candidate ran for another elected office, those contributions are not included in the totals. The amounts included are current as of March 21st, 2016.

Total Raised – Total contributions received for the 2016 election cycle as reported to the Federal Elections Commission (FEC).

Total Health Industry Contributions – Includes doctors and health care providers, pharmaceutical companies, hospitals, nursing homes and health service providers such as HMOs. (Insurance providers are found under the Finance, Insurance and Real Estate (F/I/R) heading).

Total Spent – Total amount spent for the 2016 election cycle as reported to the Federal Elections Commission (FEC).

Total Contributions from Lawyers and Lobbyists – Includes law firms and legal lobbyist groups.

Total Individual Contributions – Total contributions

made by individuals for the 2016 election cycle as reported to the Federal Elections Commission (FEC).

Total Finance/Insurance/Real Estate (F/I/R)

Contributions – Includes banks, stock brokerage and investment firms, insurance and real estate companies, accountants, commodities brokers, and all other financial services.

Total PAC Contributions – Total contributions made by PACs and other candidates' committees for the 2016 election cycle as reported to the Federal Elections Commission (FEC).

Total Energy/Natural Resources Industry

Contributions – Includes oil and gas companies, electric utility companies, mining companies as well as natural gas and waste management industries.

Since many candidates are unwilling to address the issue-related questions posed on the Political Courage Test, Vote Smart has dedicated thousands of research hours combing through candidate's public records in order to determine their likely responses on a select number of key issues. Key Issue Questions

Q1: Do you generally support pro-choice or pro-life legislation?

Q2: In order to balance the budget, do you support an income tax increase on any tax bracket?

Q3: Do you support mandatory minimum sentences for non-violent drug offenders?

Q4: Do you support federal spending as a means of promoting economic growth?

Q5: Do you support lowering taxes as a means of promoting economic growth?

Q6: Do you support requiring states to implement education reforms in order to be eligible for competitive federal grants?

Q7: Do you support building the Keystone XL pipeline?

Q8: Do you support funding for the development of renewable energy (e.g. solar, wind, thermal)?

Q9: Do you support the federal regulation of greenhouse gas emissions?

Q10: Do you generally support gun-control legislation?

Q11: Do you support repealing the 2010 Affordable Care Act ("Obamacare")?

Q12: Do you support requiring illegal immigrants to return to their country of origin before they are eligible for citizenship?

Q15: Do you support allowing individuals to divert a portion of their Social Security taxes into personal retirement accounts?

United States Senate

This section provides office information, contact information, key votes, interest group ratings, and campaign contributions for each of the 100 U.S. Senators. Also included is a measure of the official's willingness to provide his or her issue positions through Vote Smart's Political Courage Test. The senators are listed in alphabetical order by state abbreviation.

Office Information

Next to each senator's name is his or her party affiliation. Abbreviations for party affiliations are: Democratic (D); Independent (I); and Republican (R). Underneath the name is whether the senator holds the Junior or Senior seat in that state.

Contact Information

Political Courage Test

The Political Courage Test asks candidates one central question: "Are you willing to tell citizens where you stand on the issues you may face if elected?" Each election, Vote Smart organizes an effort of over 200 media organizations and political leaders who write, call, and repetitiously encourage each candidate to provide this essential information.

Senators with "Has Political Courage" listed after their seat were willing to provide citizens with their issue positions on the Political Courage Test at the time of their last election. Senators with "No Political Courage" listed after their seat refused to provide citizens with their issue positions on the Political Courage Test at the time of their last election. Senators with "Unknown Political Courage" are those officials who have not yet had the opportunity to fill out the Political Courage Test.

The Political Courage Test results from each senator's most recent test are included in this manual with the exception of 2016 results, which are still being collected. If a candidate fails to demonstrate political courage on key issue questions, Vote Smart will determine the candidate's likely positions from his or her public statements, legislative record, and interest group ratings.

Key Votes

Vote Smart provides easy access to the voting records of U.S. Senators and maintains a collection of key votes grouped by issue. Key votes typically include the initial passage of legislation, controversial amendments, and the final conference report votes. The following criteria are used to select key votes:

- The vote should be helpful in portraying how a senator stands on a particular issue
- The vote was passed or defeated by a very close margin
- The vote has received national media attention
- The vote should be clear for any person to understand
- A specific bill is consistently inquired about on the Voter's Research Hotline

Key vote summaries are written by Vote Smart staff and go through an approval process with political scientists of opposing viewpoints reviewing both the selection and the content. This is to ensure clarity, relevance, non-partisanship, and accuracy.

Below are the descriptions of the 17 U.S. Senate key votes included in this publication. The votes are numbered according to the tables and keys located on the senators' information pages. For each vote, the central issue of the bill is explained but many bills encompass more than one issue. For additional details, visit our website at votesmart.org or call our Voter's Research Hotline at 1-888-VoteSmart (1-888-868-3762). A reference key is provided on the top of each page.

1. **Budget, Spending & Taxes** (House Bill 2029): Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2016 - Vote to concur with House amendments to a bill that appropriates funds for fiscal year 2016 and extends certain tax credits (12/18/2015: Concurrence Vote, Passed 65-33⁽¹⁾)
2. **Budget, Spending & Taxes** (House Bill 1314): Bipartisan Budget Act of 2015 - Vote to concur with House amendments and pass a bill that extends the statutory limit on debt incurred by the federal government and appropriates funds for fiscal years 2016 and 2017 (10/29/2015: Concurrence Vote, Passed 64-35⁽¹⁾)
3. **Budget, Spending & Taxes** (Senate Concurrent Resolution 11): An Original Concurrent Resolution Setting Forth the Congressional Budget for the United States Government for Fiscal Year 2016 and Setting Forth the Appropriate Budgetary Levels for Fiscal Years 2017 Through 2025 - Vote to adopt a conference resolution that appropriates funds for fiscal year 2016 and establishes budget levels for fiscal years 2017 through 2025 (5/5/2015: Conference Report Vote, Passed 51-48)
4. **Defense** (House Bill 2685): Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2016 - Vote on a motion to invoke cloture on a bill that appropriates funds to the Department of Defense for fiscal year 2016 (11/5/2015: Cloture Vote, Rejected 51-44⁽²⁾)
5. **Defense** (House Bill 1735): National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) for Fiscal Year 2016 - Vote to adopt a conference report that authorizes certain appropriations to the Department of Defense for fiscal year 2016 (10/7/2015: Conference Report Vote, Passed 70-27)
6. **Employment** (Senate Bill 2569): Bring Jobs Home Act - Vote on a motion to invoke cloture on a bill that prohibits tax credits for outsourcing expenses and establishes a tax credit for insourcing expenses (7/30/2014: Cloture Vote, Rejected 54-42⁽²⁾)
7. **Employment** (Senate Amendment 798 to Senate Concurrent Resolution 11): Deficit-Neutral Reserve Fund for Legislation to Allow Americans to Earn Paid Sick Time - Vote to adopt an amendment to S Con Res 11 that authorizes the appropriation of funds for a bill that authorizes employees to earn paid sick time. (3/26/2015: Amendment Vote, Passed 61-39)

8. Environmental Issues (Senate Joint Resolution 23): A Joint Resolution Providing for Congressional Disapproval Under Chapter 8 of Title 5, United States Code, of a Rule Submitted by the Environmental Protection Agency Relating to "Standards of Performance for Greenhouse Gas Emissions from New, Modified, and Reconstructed Stationary Sources: Electric Utility Generating Units" - Vote to pass a joint resolution that repeals the rule published by the EPA on October 23, 2015 that establishes carbon dioxide emission guidelines for new, modified, and reconstructed power plants (11/17/2015: Passage Vote, Passed 52-46)

9. Executive Branch (Presidential Nomination 4): Nomination of Loretta E. Lynch to be Attorney General - Vote to confirm President Barack Obama's nomination of Loretta E. Lynch to be the Attorney General (4/23/2015: Confirmation Vote, Passed 56-43)

10. Gun Issues (Senate Amendment 2908 to House Bill 3762): Public Safety and Second Amendment Rights Protection Act of 2015 - Vote to adopt an amendment to HR 3762 that expands background check requirements for firearms purchased at gun shows and online (12/3/2015: Amendment Vote, Rejected 48-50)

11. Gun Issues (Senate Amendment 2910 to House Bill 3762): Denying Firearms and Explosives to Dangerous Terrorists Act of 2015 - Vote to adopt an amendment to HR 3762 that authorizes the Attorney General to deny the transfer of firearms to an individual suspected of engaging in terrorism (12/3/2015: Amendment Vote, Rejected 45-54)

12. Health & Health Care (House Bill 3762): Restoring Americans' Healthcare Freedom Reconciliation Act of 2015 - Vote to pass a bill that repeals certain provisions of the Affordable Care Act and rescinds funds from abortion providers (12/3/2015: Passage with Amendment Vote, Passed 52-47)

13. Immigration (Senate Bill 2146): Stop Sanctuary Policies and Protect Americans Act - Vote on a motion to invoke cloture on a bill that prohibits sanctuary jurisdictions from receiving federal grants and increases penalties for an undocumented immigrant who reenters the United States after being deported (10/20/2015: Cloture Vote, Rejected 54-45⁽²⁾)

14. National Security (House Bill 2048): Uniting and Strengthening America by Fulfilling Rights and Ensuring Effective Discipline Over Monitoring (USA FREEDOM) Act of 2015 - Vote to pass a bill that prohibits the bulk collection of personal information by the FBI (6/2/2015: Passage Vote, Passed 67-32)

15. Oil & Gas (Senate Bill 1): A Bill to Approve the Keystone XL Pipeline - Vote to override a veto of a bill that authorizes the construction and operation of the Keystone XL Pipeline and cross-border facilities, including any subsequent revisions to the Pipeline route with the State of Nebraska, and amends energy efficiency regulations and initiatives (3/4/2015: Veto Override Vote, Rejected 62-37)

16. Technology & Communication (Senate Bill 754): Cybersecurity Information Sharing Act (CISA) of 2015 - Vote to pass a bill that establishes an information system for government agencies and companies to share cyber threat indicators (10/27/2015: Passage Vote, Passed 74-21)

17. Transportation (House Bill 22): Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act - Vote to pass a bill that appropriates funds for transportation and infrastructure projects (7/30/2015: Passage with Amendment Vote, Passed 65-34)

(1) Concurrence Vote: A concurrence vote considers the changes made by the House to a bill that the Senate previously passed. A successful concurrence vote advances the bill to the president. A failed concurrence vote usually results in a "conference committee", where delegates from each chamber are convened to resolve the differences between the bills.

(2)*Cloture Vote: The Senate may limit the debate of a bill to 30 hours if at least 3/5 majority of the Senate vote “Yea” on a motion to invoke cloture. It is not a vote on the passage of the piece of legislation, but a “Yea” vote for cloture generally indicates that the senator favors the passage of the bill. A failed cloture vote often prevents the legislation from ever coming to a vote.*

Interest Group Ratings

Vote Smart collects performance evaluations from special interest groups regardless of the issue or bias of the organization. Most ratings reflect how often members of Congress or state legislators have voted with the organization's preferred position on legislation that the group considers key in their area. Some organizations may also consider other actions such as committee votes, bill sponsorship, or answers to a questionnaire in their ratings. Additionally, some groups may select votes that tend to favor members of one political party over another, rather than choosing votes based solely on issue-related concerns.

Special interest group ratings can be used to find out how your elected officials were ranked by those groups you either agree or disagree with. If your concerns do not align with those of any particular special interest group, ratings can still be useful by helping indicate where an incumbent has stood on a particular set of issues in the past few years.

For consistency, Vote Smart has converted all ratings to percentages for this publication. If a rating was not available for a senator, “NA” is listed in place of a rating.

Listed below is a sampling of interest group ratings from the more than 1800 groups in Vote Smart's database. The years listed in parentheses after the name of the organization indicate what year or years of actions the organization considered when producing the rating. The ratings are numbered according to the tables and keys located on the senator's information pages.

1. Abortion Issues: National Right to Life (2015)

Organization's Mission: “To protect those threatened by abortion, infanticide, euthanasia, and assisted suicide.”

2. Abortion & Reproductive Issues: Planned Parenthood Action Fund (2016-Lifetime through Feb. 15)

Organization's Mission: “The nation's leading provider and advocate of high-quality, affordable health care for women, men, and young people, as well as the nation's largest provider of sex education.”

3. Agriculture & Food Issues: American Farm Bureau (2014)

Organization's Mission: “To enhance and strengthen the lives of rural Americans and to build strong, prosperous agricultural communities.”

4. Budget, Spending & Taxes: Club for Growth (2014– lifetime)

Organization's Mission: “To reduce income tax rates, death tax repeal, limited government through limited spending and budget reform, including a Balanced Budget Amendment to the United States Constitution, Social Security reform with personal retirement accounts for younger workers, expanding trade freedom (free trade), end abusive lawsuits through medical malpractice and tort reform, replacing the current tax code (flat tax, fair tax), school choice, regulatory reform and deregulation.”

5. Business & Consumers: US Chamber of Commerce (2015-lifetime)

Organization's Mission: “To fight for business and free enterprise before Congress, the White House, regulatory agencies, the courts, the court of public opinion, and governments around the world.”

6. Civil Liberties & Civil Rights: American Civil Liberties Union (ACLU) (2015)

Organization's Mission: “To defend and preserve the individual rights and liberties that

the Constitution and laws of the United States guarantee everyone in this country. The ACLU's mission is to conserve America's original civic values: the Constitution and the Bill of Rights."

7. Civil Liberties & Civil Rights: National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP) (2014)

Organization's Mission: "To ensure the political, educational, social, and economic equality of rights of all persons and to eliminate racial hatred and racial discrimination."

8. Education: National Education Association (NEA) (2015)

Organization's Mission: "To fulfill the promise of public education to prepare every student to succeed in a diverse and interdependent world."

9. Environmental Issues: Environment America (2015)

Organization's Mission: "A federation of state-based, citizen-funded environmental groups working for clean air, clean water, and open space."

10. Foreign Aid & Policy Issues: Council for a Livable World (2015)

Organization's Mission: "To reduce and eventually eliminate nuclear weapons and to minimize the risk of war through lobbying and by helping elect and support Members of Congress who share our goals."

11. Government Budget & Spending: Citizens Against Government Waste (2015)

Organization's Mission: "To eliminate waste, mismanagement, and inefficiency in the federal government."

12. Gun Issues: Gun Owners of America (2015)

Organization's Mission: "To preserve and defend the Second Amendment rights of gun owners. GOA sees firearms ownership as a freedom issue."

13. Immigration: NumbersUSA (1989-2015)

Organization's Mission: "Improve border security, to stop illegal immigration, and to promote immigration levels consistent with the national interest—more traditional rates of about 300,000 a year."

14. Labor: AFL-CIO (2014 – lifetime)

Organization's Mission: "Improving the lives of working families, bringing fairness and dignity to the workplace and securing social equity in the Nation."

15. Marriage, Family & Children: Family Research Council (2015)

Organization's Mission: "To advance faith, family and freedom in public policy and the culture from a Christian worldview."

16. Senior & Social Security Issues: Alliance for Retired Americans (2015 – lifetime)

Organization's Mission: "To ensure social and economic justice and full civil rights for all citizens so that they may enjoy lives of dignity, personal and family fulfillment and security."

17. Welfare & Poverty: RESULTS (2015)

Organization's Mission: "Creating the political will to end hunger and the worst aspects of poverty."

Political Courage Test

The Political Courage Test asks candidates one central question: "Are you willing to tell citizens where you stand on the issues you may face if elected?" Each election, Vote Smart organizes an effort of over 200 media organizations and political leaders who write, call, and repetitiously encourage each candidate to provide this essential information.

Representatives with "Has Political Courage" listed after their seat were willing to provide citizens with their issue positions on the Political Courage Test at the time of their last election. Representatives with "No Political Courage" listed after their seat refused to provide citizens with their issue positions on the Political Courage Test at the time of their last election. Representatives with "Unknown Political Courage" are those officials who have not yet had the opportunity to fill out the Political Courage Test.

The Political Courage Test results from each representative's most recent test are included in this manual with the exception of 2016 results which are still being collected. If a candidate fails to demonstrate Political Courage on key issue questions, Vote Smart will determine the candidate's likely positions from his or her public statements, legislative record, and interest group ratings.

Key Votes

Vote Smart provides easy access to the voting records of U.S. Representatives and maintains a collection of key votes grouped by issue. Key votes typically include the initial passage of legislation, controversial amendments, and the final conference report votes. Vote Smart uses the following criteria to select key votes:

- The vote should be helpful in portraying how a representative stands on a particular issue
- The vote was passed or defeated by a very close margin
- The vote has received national media attention
- The vote should be clear for any person to understand
- A specific bill is consistently inquired about on the Voter's Research Hotline

Key Vote summaries are written by Vote Smart staff and go through an approval process with political scientists of opposing viewpoints reviewing both the selection and the content. This is to ensure clarity, relevance, nonpartisanship, and accuracy.

Below are the descriptions of the 17 U.S. House of Representatives key votes that are included in this publication. The votes are numbered according to the tables and keys located on the Representative's information pages. For each vote, the central issue of the bill is highlighted but many bills encompass more than one issue. 2. **Abortion & Reproductive Issues** (House Bill 3134): Defund Planned Parenthood Act of 2015 - Vote to pass a bill that rescinds funds from Planned Parenthood (9/18/2015: Passage Vote, Passed 241-187)
3. **Budget, Spending & Taxes** (House Bill 2029): Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2016 - Vote to concur with Senate amendments and adopt additional amendments to a bill that appropriates funds for fiscal year 2016 and extends certain tax credits (12/17/2015: Concurrence with Amendment Vote, Passed 318-109)
4. **Budget, Spending & Taxes** (House Bill 1314): Bipartisan Budget Act of 2015 - Vote to concur with House amendments and pass a bill that extends the statutory limit on debt incurred by the federal government and appropriates funds for fiscal years 2016 and 2017 (10/29/2015: Concurrence Vote, Passed 266-167)⁽¹⁾
5. **Defense** (House Bill 1735): National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) for Fiscal Year 2016 - Vote to adopt a conference report that authorizes certain appropriations to the Department of Defense for fiscal year 2016 (10/1/2015: Conference Report Vote, Passed 270-156)
6. **Employment** (House Bill 30): Save American Workers Act of 2015 - Vote to pass a bill that increases the number of hours that an employee is required to work per week from

30 to 40 in order to be considered a full-time employee for the purpose of the employer mandate in the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (1/8/2015: Passage Vote, Passed 252-172)

7. **Energy** (House Bill 8): North American Energy Security and Infrastructure Act - Vote to pass a bill that authorizes the export of crude oil and amends certain energy infrastructure regulations (12/3/2015: Passage Vote, Passed 249-174)

8. **Environmental Issues** (Senate Joint Resolution 23): A Joint Resolution Providing for Congressional Disapproval Under Chapter 8 of Title 5, United States Code, of a Rule Submitted by the Environmental Protection Agency Relating to "Standards of Performance for Greenhouse Gas Emissions from New, Modified, and Reconstructed Stationary Sources: Electric Utility Generating Units" - Vote to pass a joint resolution that repeals the rule published by the EPA of October 23, 2015 that establishes carbon dioxide emission guidelines for new, modified, and reconstructed power plants (12/1/2015: Passage Vote, Passed 235-188)

9. **Food Processing & Sales** (House Bill 1599): Safe and Accurate Food Labeling Act of 2015 - Vote to pass a bill that prohibits mandatory labeling for food produced from, containing, or consisting of a bio-engineered organism (7/23/2015: Passage Vote, Passed 275-150)

10. **Foreign Aid & Policy Issues** (House Bill 3460): To Suspend Until January 21, 2017, the Authority of the President to Waive, Suspend, Reduce, Provide Relief from, or Otherwise Limit the Application of Sanctions Pursuant to an Agreement Related to the Nuclear Program of Iran - Vote to pass a bill that prohibits the president from reducing certain sanctions on Iran until January 21, 2017 (9/11/2015: Passage Vote, Passed 247-186)

11. **Government Operations** (House Bill 50): Unfunded Mandates Information and Transparency Act of 2015 - Vote to pass a bill that requires federal agencies to conduct a more detailed assessment of the costs and effects of federal regulations on state, local, and tribal governments and the private sector (2/4/2015: Passage vote, Passed 250-173)

12. **Health Insurance** (House Bill 3762): Restoring Americans' Healthcare Freedom Reconciliation Act of 2015 - Vote to pass a bill that repeals certain provisions of the Affordable Care Act and rescinds funds from abortion providers (10/23/2015: Passage Vote, Passed 240-189)

13. **K-12 Education** (House Bill 5): Student Success Act - Vote to pass a bill that expands state and local authority over public education (7/8/2015: Passage Vote, Passed 218-213)

14. **National Security** (House Bill 4038): American Security Against Foreign Enemies (SAFE) Act - Vote to pass a bill that expands background checks for Syrian and Iraqi refugees applying for admission to the United States (11/19/2015: Passage Vote, Passed 289-137)

15. **Oil & Gas** (Senate Bill 1): A Bill to Approve the Keystone XL Pipeline - Vote to pass a bill that authorizes the construction, operation, and maintenance of the Keystone XL Pipeline project, including cross-border facilities, and establishes certain energy efficiency requirements (2/11/2015: Passage Vote, Passed 270-152)

16. **Taxes** (House Bill 1105): Death Tax Repeal Act of 2015 - Vote to pass a bill that repeals the estate tax and the generation-skipping transfer tax (4/16/2015: Passage Vote, Passed 240-179)

17. **Transportation** (House Bill 22): Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act - Vote to concur with Senate amendments and adopt additional amendments to a bill that appropriates funds for transportation and infrastructure projects (11/5/2015: Concurrence with Amendment Vote, Passed 363-64)

(1) Concurrence Vote: A concurrence vote considers the changes made by the Senate to a bill that the House previously passed. A successful concurrence vote advances the bill to the president. A failed concurrence vote usually results in a "conference committee", where delegates from each chamber are convened to resolve the differences between the bills.

Interest Group Ratings

Vote Smart collects performance evaluations from special interest groups regardless of the issue or bias of the organization. Most ratings reflect how often members of Congress or state legislators have voted with the organization's preferred position on legislation that the group considers key in their area. Some organizations may also consider other actions such as committee votes, bill sponsorship, or answers to a questionnaire in their ratings. Additionally, some groups may select votes that tend to favor members of one political party over another, rather than choosing votes based solely on issue-related concerns.

Special interest group ratings can be used to find out how your elected officials were ranked by those groups you either agree or disagree with. If your concerns do not align with those of any particular special interest group, ratings can still be useful by helping indicate where an incumbent has stood on a particular set of issues in the past few years.

For consistency, Vote Smart has converted all ratings to percentages for this publication. If a rating was not available for a representative, (NA) is listed in place of a rating.

Listed below is a sampling of interest group ratings selected from the more than 1800 groups in Vote Smart's database. The years listed in parentheses after the name of the organization indicate what year or years of actions the organization considered when producing the rating.
