## RE: Senate Bill 376 of the 75<sup>th</sup> Legislative Session

Dear Secretary Miller,

I am herewith forwarding to you, for filing within the constitutional time limit and without my approval, Senate Bill 376, which is entitled:

AN ACT relating to labor; making various changes relating to the establishment of the prevailing rates of wages in each county; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

This bill pertains to prevailing wage requirements for county public works projects. By expanding the scope of projects considered by the Labor Commissioner in setting prevailing wage rates, this bill would effectively increase the costs of all county public works projects. Senate Bill 376 continues the distressing practice of the 75<sup>th</sup> Legislative Session of increasing government spending while ignoring the economic recession gripping our state and nation. Our citizens deserve better from their government.
