Dear Interim Secretary Roberts:

By the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Florida, under the provisions of Article III, Section 8, of the Constitution of Florida, I do hereby withhold my approval of and transmit to you my objections to House Bill 545, enacted during the 112<sup>th</sup> Session of the Legislature of Florida, since statehood in 1845, during the Regular Session of 2010 and entitled:

An act relating to residential property sales...

HB 545 repeals a very good Florida law which will provide home buyers in wind-borne debris regions with a clear and easy to understand grade on the quality of a home's hurricane resistant protections. The information can be tremendously helpful for Floridians seeking the right home for their needs. There is no compelling reason to repeal this consumer-friendly law.

For the reason stated above, I am hereby withholding my approval of House Bill 545, and do hereby veto the same.
