TO THE MISSISSIPPI STATE SENATE:

GOVERNOR'S VETO MESSAGE FOR SENATE BILL 2858

I am returning Senate Bill Number 2858: "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 79-29-1203, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO EXTEND THE REPEAL DATE ON LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY FEES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES" without my approval, and assign the following reasons for my veto.

Senate Bill 2858 and House Bill 416 both extend the July 1, 2012 repeal date on Section 79-29-1203, Mississippi Code of 1972, with Senate Bill 2858 extending the repeal date to July 1, 2016, and House Bill 416 extending the repeal date to July 1, 2015. Both bills are effective from and after July 1, 2012. Additionally, House Bill 1162 amends Section 79-29-1203, among numerous other code sections, by extending the repeal date on the section to July 1, 2015, with the bill having an effective date of January 1, 2013. I signed House Bill 416 and House Bill 1162 into law on April 17, 2012, to insure that the repeal date would be extended on July 1, 2012, until July 1, 2015. Therefore, there is no need for Senate Bill 2858.
