ENROLLED HOUSE BILL NO. 3417:

This is to advise you that on this date, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Section 11 of Article VI of the Oklahoma Constitution to approve or object to legislation presented to me, I have VETOED House Bill 3417.

House Bill 3417 forbids any law enforcement agency or task force from entering into contracts with non-law-enforcement and non-departmental entities or persons. This Bill is intended to prevent the outsourcing of law enforcement responsibilities, but is overly broad in its scope. As written, this Bill would restrict interagency cooperation and hinder law enforcement efforts across Oklahoma by not allowing law enforcement agencies to work with any entity outside of their department. This Bill, while well intentioned, serves no significant interest of the citizens of the State of Oklahoma.
