VETO MESSAGE - No. 193

TO THE SENATE:

I am returning herewith, without my approval, the following bills:

Senate Bill Number 1005, entitled:

"AN ACT in relation to legalizing, validating, ratifying and confirming a transportation contract of the Perry central school district"

Senate Bill Number 4234-A, entitled:

"AN ACT in relation to legalizing, validating, ratifying and confirming a transportation contract of the Fairport central school district"

Senate Bill Number 5669-A, entitled:

"AN ACT relating to legalizing, validating, ratifying and confirming a transportation contract of the Plainview-Old Bethpage Central School District"

NOT APPROVED

Each of these bills would authorize, outside the State Budget process, payment of State education aid above the amounts calculated and previously agreed to under current law.

These bills would validate transportation contracts of the Perry Central School District, the Fairport Central School District, and the Plainview-Old Bethpage Central School District, respectively, even though each of these districts failed to meet long-standing statutory requirements for aid eligibility. Further, each of these bills would result in increased and unbudgeted State costs. The transportation contracts fall outside the scope of forgiveness provisions that were negotiated by the Legislature and the Executive and included in the 2012-13 Enacted Budget, thereby undoing that agreed upon solution.

Further, in the case of the Perry Central School District, this legislation may be unnecessary because the district received additional funding through alternate measures.

For the reasons stated above, I cannot approve these bills.

These bills are disapproved.
