VETO MESSAGE - No. 224

TO THE ASSEMBLY:

I am returning herewith, without my approval, the following bill:

Assembly Bill Number 1335, entitled:

"AN ACT to amend the state administrative procedure act, in relation to improving evaluations of the potential impact of rules on jobs and employment opportunities"

NOT APPROVED

This bill would amend the State Administrative Procedure Act (SAPA) to increase the analysis requirements for State agencies in the SAPA rule-making process by mandating the inclusion of additional information in the Job Impact Statement. It would also require the Commissioners of the Departments of Labor and Economic Development to review, evaluate, and comment on the Job Impact Statements accompanying proposed regulations.

Ensuring that proposed regulations are properly evaluated for their impact on jobs and employment opportunities is an important function of State government. However, SAPA already requires such reviews to safeguard and minimize against any negative impacts.

This bill would also substantially impede the publication of proposed regulations for public comment. Further, it would require the Commissioners to review all proposed rules with any notable job impact, and in doing so, add a significant administrative burden without any additional funding. For these reasons, I am constrained to veto this bill.

The bill is disapproved.
