

## 1995 VETO MESSAGES OF HOUSE BILLS

### **H 227 MEDICAID PROGRAM EFFICIENCIES**

April 5, 1995

#### **HOUSE EXECUTIVE MESSAGE NO. 62**

I have this day VETOED and am returning HOUSE BILL 227, as amended, enacted by the Forty-Second Legislature, State of New Mexico, First Session, 1995.

This legislation would create a statutory mandate to require the Human Services Department ensure that the Medicaid program operates efficiently, implements public information campaigns, and reports annually to the legislature. It is vetoed because a statutory mandate is inappropriate, and these issues should be addressed by the Human Services Department at a proper time.

#### **HOUSE EXECUTIVE MESSAGE NO. 41**

I have this day VETOED and am returning HOUSE BILL 229, as amended, enacted by the Forty-Second Legislature, State of New Mexico, First Session, 1995.

This legislation would allow the Human Services Department to increase Medicaid reimbursement payments in areas of New Mexico which are deemed to be medically underserved. This legislation is regrettably vetoed because the fiscal year 1996 appropriation for the Medicaid program does not provide for the increased costs which this legislation entails.
